Psalm 110

The main idea of the psalm: The rule of the Lord will begin with the defeat of His enemies and will usher in worship.

Context of the Psalms: Psalm 110 is near the beginning of the last book of the five books of the psalms. This Book 5 of the Psalms has many psalms that depict the coming messianic kingdom.

The main imagery of the psalm: A heavenly throne room and then a battlefield

Four scenes: The psalm moves through four scenes with two speeches and then two descriptions by a "narrator".

Scene 1: The End of the Rebellion

Psalm 110

[1] The <u>LORD</u> says to my <u>Lord</u>: "Sit at my right hand, <u>until</u> I make <u>your enemies your footstool</u>." [2] The LORD sends forth <u>from Zion your mighty scepter</u>. Rule in the midst of your enemies! [3] <u>Your people will offer themselves freely</u> on the day of your power, in holy garments; <u>I have begotten you</u> from the womb before the morning.

This first scene pictures the LORD (Yahweh) and His messiah (Lord- Adonai) in the heavenly throne room (see Psalm 2). In v.1, Yahweh honors the Messiah and has Him sit on the throne until His enemies are defeated. From Zion, the Messiah will reign over all humanity. The people of the Lord will worship and serve Him in the kingdom. The Messiah is the begotten Son (see Psalm 2).

Scene 2: The Great Priest

Psalm 110

[4] The LORD has sworn and will not change his mind, "You are a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek."

The LORD's decree and purpose is not just for the Son to be the king but also a great priest. In Hebrews 10:11-13, Jesus is seen as the great priest-king, using Ps.110 (see also Heb.1 for Jesus as the great prophet). His priestly role means two great promises: 1) He calls people into a worship relationship with the Lord; 2) He makes the sacrifice that allows sinful people to come before a holy God.

His sacrifice lasts forever because He is a forever priest.

Scene 3: The King Brings Judgment Psalm 110

[5] The Lord is at your right hand; <u>he will shatter kings on the day of his wrath</u>. [6] <u>He will execute judgment among the nations</u>, filling them with corpses; <u>he will shatter chiefs</u> over the wide earth.

The beginning of the Lord's reign is marked by judgment. First, He defeats His enemies in battle. His wrath is justified because these "kings" have been in rebellion (see Ps 2). After their defeat (death), rebellious humans face the Lord for judgment. This judgment is universal in that no one, regardless of position ("chiefs") or location ("wide earth"), avoids this judgment. The judgment is final because there is no appeal, and the sentence is death.

Scene 4: The Peaceful Kingdom

Psalm 110

[7] <u>He will drink from the brook</u> by the way; therefore, <u>he will lift up</u> his head.

The final scene of the psalm is one of peace after the battle. The warrior king now refreshes Himself from a brook, a serene scene fitting to the victor. The peace that He establishes is everlasting because He has vanquished every foe. He establishes justice because every rebellion against His character and purposes is judged.

The Bible holds out the hope of the peaceful kingdom for all who would believe in the King. He gives believers eternal life in His kingdom.

Scene 4: The Peaceful Kingdom

Isaiah 9:6-7

[6] For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. [7] Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this.

Revelation 22:12-14

[12] "Behold, I am coming soon, bringing my recompense with me, to repay each one for what he has done. [13] I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end." [14] Blessed are those who wash their robes, so that they may have the right to the tree of life and that they may enter the city by the gates.

Responding to the Psalms:

Worship the Lord as the king.

Though His enemies have not yet submitted to Him (as they will), we can already worship and exalt Him. He rules the church now.

Worship the Lord as your priest.

We have access to the Lord because of the work of Jesus. We can pray (go ahead and do it), confess our sins (go ahead and do it), and sing our praises to the Lord (yes, this too) because of Christ.

Come to Him for peace.

Is your life filled uncertainty and turmoil? Trust your week to Him. Is your heart filled with guilt and shame? Trust your past to Him. Are you worried about what is just around the corner or even years ahead? Trust your whole life to Him. He is peace.
