

Psalm 131-133

The main idea of these psalms: The Messiah, Jesus, is our eternal hope, our eternal king, and our eternal life.

Context of the Psalms: Psalms 131-133 are in the Psalms of Ascent which is a series of psalms that call the people of God to go up to Zion to worship.

The main imagery of the psalms: Psalm 131 pictures childlike faith. Psalms 132 pictures the Son of David as king and worship leader. Psalm 133 pictures the anointing of Aaron as priest.

Psalm 131 calls for our hope to be in the Lord forever. Psalm 132 pictures the eternal reign of the Son of David. Psalm 133 pictures eternal life as peace forever and the worship of God.

Psalm 132: A Forever Reign [A Reminder]

[11] The LORD swore to David a sure oath from which he will not turn back: "One of the sons of your body I will set on your throne. [12] If your sons keep my covenant and my testimonies that I shall teach them, their sons also forever shall sit on your throne."

[13] For the LORD has chosen Zion; he has desired it for his dwelling place: [14] "This is my resting place forever; here I will dwell, for I have desired it. [15] I will abundantly bless her provisions; I will satisfy her poor with bread. [16] Her priests I will clothe with salvation, and her saints will shout for joy. [17] There I will make a horn to sprout for David; I have prepared a lamp for my anointed. [18] His enemies I will clothe with shame, but on him his crown will shine."

Psalm 131: A Forever Hope

Ps 131:[1] O LORD, my heart is not lifted up; my eyes are not raised too high; I do not occupy myself with things too great and too marvelous for me. [2] But I have calmed and quieted my soul, like a weaned child with its mother; like a weaned child is my soul within me. [3] O Israel, hope in the LORD from this time forth and forevermore.

Psalm 130 pictures a person who is waiting on the Lord and has placed her/ his hope in the Lord because of what is revealed in the Word (See Ps 130:5). Psalm 131 picks up on this theme of hoping in the Lord. Here the picture is extended into eternity. We do not just hope in the Lord during hard circumstances now but will hope in Him forever. The humility of a child is needed.

Psalm 133: A Forever Life

133:[1] Behold, how good and pleasant it is when brothers dwell in unity! [2] It is like the precious oil on the head, running down on the beard, on the beard of Aaron, running down on the collar of his robes! [3] It is like the dew of Hermon, which falls on the mountains of Zion! For there the LORD has commanded the blessing, life forevermore.

In Psalm 132, the Son of David reigns forever and establishes the worship of the Lord. In that psalm, the people of faith are invited to come up and worship the Lord. Now, in Ps 133, the people of God have been united in worship under the Son of David. The anointing of priests (Aaron) pictures abundant worship. In this worship context, the Lord's blessing of eternal life.

Responding to the Psalms:

Humbly hope in the Lord.

The Lord has kept His promises in the past and He will keep His promises for the future. When we recognize our weaknesses and failures then we can rely on Him instead of ourselves.

Worship the Lord as one of His people.

We have access to the Lord because of the work of Jesus. God has made promises of making a kingdom of worshippers through the reign of His son, the Messiah. We are made saints and worship through Christ.

Come to the Lord for eternal life.

By faith, we can participate in the first fruits of eternal life now. By faith, we can rejoice now in the hope of everything being made right.
