

The Big Idea

In Christ, our relationships in the church and outside of the church have been given new intentionality.

- Our new life in Christ has radically reordered our relationships in the church and in the home. (3:12-4:1)
- 2. Pray for open doors for gospel conversations. (4:2-4)
- The urgency of the gospel prompts a gracious, truthful witness. (4:5-6)

Our new life in Christ has radically reordered our relationships in the church and in the home. (3:12-4:1)

After describing the traits that characterize the person who has been transformed into a new creation, Paul summarizes the new relationships in the church. He says, [3:14] And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.

These new relationships also are also notable in everyday life, including the home. Paul writes, [3:17] And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

Every moment and every relationship is an opportunity to reflect the Lord's saving work in us. Whatever we say and how we act in the church, in our homes, and in society should come under <u>submission to Jesus</u> the "Lord" over us.

Our new life in Christ has radically reordered our relationships in the church and in the home. (3:12-4:1)

The challenge for us is often how will our new obedience to Christ overcome our tendency to honor, comfort, protect, and find pleasure for ourselves. Christ-honoring homes are seen in "new creation" relationships. These new relationships include wives submitting graciously to their husbands, husbands loving their wives more than themselves, children honoring and obeying their parents, and father and mothers instructing their children in how to endure in their faith. They also include a submission to those who have authority over us in our workplace or in society (Rom.13), even when those authorities misuse their authority. God sees and He brings reward and revenge: [3:24] knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ. [25] For the wrongdoer will be paid back for the wrong he has done, and there is no partiality.

Pray for open doors for gospel conversations. (4:2-4)

Having describe the ideal relationships and lifestyle for Christian relationships, Paul turns his intention toward Christian interactions with those outside the church. First, Paul points out that praying for these interactions will give us a sensitivity to God's purposes for our interactions. Second, we are specifically to pray for and look for "open doors" to share the gospel through the spoken word. Notice, Paul's intention in these conversations is to "declare the mystery of Christ". The gospel has specific content that must be shared with words.

A Guide to a Gospel Conversation

o Our Problem

Despite God's good creation, humans sinned and are now dead in their sins.

God's Provision

God graciously provides the Son as an atoning sacrifice that is a substitute for all who believe.

Our Response

Having heard the call of the gospel, anyone who believes in Christ's death and resurrection and confesses
Him as Lord will be saved.

Our New Life

By believing in Christ, people are given the life of the Spirit.

Because of the Spirit, the believers are the children of God and will live in the eternal kingdom.

The urgency of the gospel prompts a gracious, truthful witness. (4:5-6)

Our lives are marked with urgency because of the uncertainties of life and our natural tendency to resist God. Though the gospel is an offence to our natural unbelief, our conversations should demonstrate the grace of God in tone and content. Each person's resistance to the gospel is unique, which is why it often takes many times of gospel interactions to help answer their objections and to explain God's grace towards them.

Living the Christ-centered life:

Do your relationships in the church, your family, and in your daily interactions display your new life in Christ?

Our lives should reflect the fruit of the Spirit. That fruit is not only individual traits but should also transform our relationships.

Have you been praying for open doors for the gospel?

Our praying about open doors and our sensitivity to them go hand in hand. Pray for open doors. Pray for eyes to see the open doors. Pray for the boldness to walk through them.

Are you prepared for a gospel conversation?

Every conversation is unique, and every conversation needs gracious and good listening. You can also be prepared for the conversations by having a basic flow of the gospel with scriptural references ready in your mind.
