Romans 5:1-5

Romans 5:1-2 (a review)

[1] Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. [2] Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Through the first four chapters of this book Paul has been describing the good news of God (the gospel) that was promised in the Scriptures. In Romans 1:1-6, this good news focuses on the person and the work of Christ. From Romans 1:16-18, Paul explains that this gospel is God's power to save anyone even though they deserve God's wrath. No one (Jew or Gentile) has an excuse because "none is righteous" and "all have turned aside" (Romans 3:10-12). In Romans 3, Paul explains how God's justifying righteousness, which comes through faith, is His gracious remedy to human sinfulness.

Romans 3:21-26

[21] But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it—[22] the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction: [23] for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, [24] and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, [25] whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins. [26] It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus. (ESV)

Romans 5:1-2 (a review)

[1] Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. [2] Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

We were separated from God by our sin, but we have been brought near to Him by faith, not for judgment but for relationship.

This change of status happens through believing in (submitting to) our **Lord** (ruler, creator, sustainer) **Jesus** (savior, redeemer) **Christ** (king, promised ruler of peace). The peace with God for our future (in His kingdom) and for now in our daily lives comes through believing in Jesus.

Romans 5:3-4

[3] Not only that, but <u>we rejoice in our sufferings</u>, knowing that suffering produces endurance, [4] and endurance produces character, and <u>character produces hope</u>,

Rejoicing now in the future glory of God may be difficult but at least it makes some obvious sense to us. We understand that we should act now in light of the future reign of God.

But Paul raises the difficulty in v.4 with "Not only that" but that we should "rejoice in our sufferings". The reasoning for why Paul says to rejoice in suffering is not some masochism but of the result of a **process that begins with suffering**. Implied from v.1-2 is that faith must accompany each step along the way, or the process will be sidetracked. Each step of the process is important.

Romans 5:5

[5] and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

How is it that Christian hope "does not put us to shame"? Christian hope is built on two realities that are missing from other so-called hopes. The first reality that is a foundation of Christian hope is found in v.2, God's glory. At the end of all things God will be glorified. No power, no event, and no human failure will thwart God's glory. He will be recognized by all. The second reality that grounds Christian hope is here in v.5, the Holy Spirit living in the believer. Our endurance and our character does not come from us but from the Holy Spirit living in us. Our hope is Him.

Believe in Christ to find peace with God.

Do you need to place your trust in God to forgive you of your sins and bring you into a right relationship with Him? If you are hearing this appeal and are sensing the call of God, the only thing hindering you from being at peace with God is your unbelief. So, believe in Christ as Savior and Lord.

Commit your suffering to the Lord.

Believers, are you embittered by your suffering? Our tribulations and sufferings are painful and often feel overwhelming. In these moments, we are in an intense battle for faith. Will we choose faith in these moments, allowing God work in us through these trials?

Rejoice in the hope of God.

God does not remove us from all pain because of our faith. Instead, His Spirit comes alongside of us and strengthens us along the way. Enduring suffering with faith produces godly character in us. The presence of God within us is our hope now.
