Justified Sinners Need Mercy

In Romans 5, Paul tells us how God has dealt definitively with our sin through Jesus. He writes in 5:1, "Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ." He also tells us that because we have peace with God that we will not face the wrath of God. He writes in 5:9, "Since, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God." God has dealt finally with our sin and yet we continue to sin. So, how should we respond to our sin a daily basis when God has dealt with it on an eternal basis? Cry out to Him for mercy.

Psalm 51:1-4

- [1] Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions.
- [2] Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin!
- [3] For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me.
- [4] Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you may be justified in your words and blameless in your judgment. (ESV)

The primary plea is for mercy. Notice the basis of this plea is God's steadfast love (Exodus 34:6-7).

[1] Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions.

The plea for mercy pivots to a plea for forgiveness.

[2] Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin! [3] For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. [4] Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you may be justified in your words and blameless in your judgment.

Psalm 51:5-9

- [5] Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me.
- [6] Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being, and you teach me wisdom in the secret heart.
- [7] Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.
- [8] Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones that you have broken rejoice.
- [9] Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities.

In every justified sinner, there is an ongoing battle between our sinful nature and the new wisdom that God puts in us.

[5] Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me. [6] Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being, and you teach me wisdom in the secret heart.

Notice the redemptive and restorative power of forgiveness.

[7] Purge me with hyssop, and <u>I shall be clean</u>; wash me, and I shall be <u>whiter than snow</u>. [8] Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones that you have broken <u>rejoice</u>. [9] Hide your face from my sins, and <u>blot out all my iniquities</u>.

Psalm 51:10-12

- [10] Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.

God's mercy is rich and multi-faceted. His mercy brings forgiveness, but also a renewed spirit of obedience.

[10] Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.

God's mercy also brings a renewed fellowship with Him and the joy that comes with that fellowship. In the NT, this is enabled by the indwelling of the Spirit.

[11] Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me. [12] Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.

When God pours His mercy on a sinner for forgiveness and a renewed walk with Him, then other results come also:

Teaching and testimony- [13] Then I will teach transgressors your ways, and sinners will return to you.

Worship (corporate)- [14] Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, O God of my salvation, and my tongue will sing aloud of your righteousness. [15] O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise.

Humble obedience- [16] For you will not delight in sacrifice, or I would give it; you will not be pleased with a burnt offering. [17] The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.

Psalm 51:18-19

[18] Do good to Zion in your good pleasure; build up the walls of Jerusalem;

[19] then will you delight in right sacrifices, in burnt offerings and whole burnt offerings; then bulls will be offered on your altar. (ESV)

The final images of this psalm is of the people of God enjoying together the riches of God's mercy. Because of God's mercy they have become a worshipping and obedient people. Their hearts are now full of Him!

Praise God who loved you in your sin.

We have seen in Romans 5 and now Psalm 51 that God loves sinners. Because of His steadfast love toward sinners, we can have a relationship with Him (peace) and praise Him as our merciful God.

Have you come to a recognition of your sin?

David cried out for mercy because he was aware of his sin. He had tried to hide his sin and justify his sin, but he finally turned to God and admitted the depth of his sin. Mercy and forgiveness come as we admit our sin and its depth.

Find your life in Christ.

Romans 5:18 says, "Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men." If you have not trusted Christ to deal with your sin, then place your faith in God's merciful provision for your sin... the death of Christ. If you are believer, praise the merciful God who gives us eternal life (Rom. 5:21)
