

The Spirit Guarantees: Ephesians 1

The Holy Spirit in
Ephesians



Ephesians 1:11–14

[11] In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will, [12] so that we who were the first to hope in Christ might be to the praise of his glory. [13] In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, [14] who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory. (ESV)

Ephesians 1

In the first part of this chapter (vv.3-10), Paul lays out the spiritual blessings that God has planned for those who believe in the Lord. Paul starts with the promises that were given to believing Jews who receive Jesus as the Messiah. In those early verses (cf. 5, 8), Paul refers to God's "purpose" and His "will" being to "unite all things in him."

1:9-10

[9] making known to us the mystery of his will, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ [10] as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.

Ephesians 1:11–14

Paul asserts that God had always planned to include the new Gentile believers in this plan, but that Jews like him, were the first to believe in Christ. Believing in Christ, the Beloved Son (v.6) means sharing in His inheritance. As people believe in Christ, He adds to His people, to His praise.

[11] In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will, [12] so that we who were the first to hope in Christ might be to the praise of his glory.

Ephesians 1:11–14

In v.13, Paul pivots to the way the Gentiles have been brought into these promises, through the gospel. Just like v.11, the key of v.13 is being “in Him” through believing in Him. The promises of Christ are not in doubt because believers are “sealed with the promised Holy Spirit.” The Spirit indwells believers and guarantees that every promise made in Christ will indeed come to be, to His praise.

Ephesians 1:15–20

Notice two key character traits that Paul mentions for these new believers (Gentile and Jews). They have “faith in the Lord Jesus” and “love” for each other. Having noticed these traits in the Ephesian church, Paul prays the Spirit grants them wisdom and revelation. Wisdom pairs discernment and obedience. Revelation results in a personal and intellectual knowledge of God. These are both gifts with the Spirit.

Paul concludes the chapter by reminding the church of blessings that the Spirit brings: a true hope of an inheritance and the power that brings resurrection.

The Spirit guarantees:

- **Believers in Christ (both Jews and Gentiles) will be united into one, glorious, resurrected people.**
 - Let's respond by growing faith and abundant love for each other.
- **Believers in Christ will inherit eternal life and the blessings of the kingdom.**
 - Let's respond by walking in the new life that we have and the power of the Spirit as God's children.
- **Believers in Christ can have wisdom & knowledge of God.**
 - The Spirit has inspired the Scriptures as the means for us to grow in the wisdom of God. Let's respond by knowing God by reading His revelation to us.
