## The Spirit Builds: Ephesians 2

The Holy Spirit in  
Ephesians



### Ephesians 2:17-22

[17] And he came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near. [18] For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. [19] So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, [20] built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, [21] in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. [22] In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit. (ESV)

## Ephesians 2

In the first part of this chapter (vv.1-16), Paul lays out the spiritual blessings that God has poured out by His rich mercy (vv.4-5). God's "kindness towards us in Christ Jesus" results us being able to be "saved through faith" (vv.7-8). In v.11, Paul reemphasizes that this gracious plan of God has included "Gentiles in the flesh". Despite being separated from God by their sin and their ignorance of His covenants, they are now brought near through Christ. See vv.12-14.

## Ephesians 2

**2:12-14:**

**[12] remember that you were at that time separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. [13] But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. [14] For he himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility**

## Ephesians 2:17-18

Since Christ is our peace, Paul asserts that Jesus came to preach peace to those far off (gentiles) and to those near (Jews). The gospel of Jesus is the means of salvation (peace) for anyone who will believe. Paul then says that believers in Jesus now have access to God the Father by the Spirit. Just as Jesus is the one sacrifice, the Spirit (in us) is the one access to the Father. There are no other prerequisites.

## Ephesians 2:19-20

All believers in Christ, regardless of background (religious or not), ethnicity, or status (geographic or socio-economic), have been brought together by the Spirit as “fellow citizens” with the “saints” (implies a new faith family/identity). The Spirit is building this new household (house) on the foundation of the apostles (NT) and prophets (OT). Christ is the foundation stone (Mt 16:16-18, 1 Pet. 2:4-10).

**[19] So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, [20] built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone,**



## Ephesians 2:21-22

Paul ends this section with glorious vision of the end result of the Spirit's work of building redeemed people into a house. God will dwell with His people (Rev. 21:3) for eternity. However, as we saw in chapter 1, the Spirit gives us a guarantee and is the foretaste of these future promises. As Paul notes in v.22, God already dwells with His people by His Spirit. The Spirit is building (growing) us into the people with which God will dwell eternally.

### The Spirit builds:

- **Believers in Christ are built by the Spirit on the biblical gospel as a message about Christ.**
  - Let's respond by believing the message of the Bible about new life and peace is found in Christ.
- **Believers in Christ are reconciled to God and to each other by the power of the Spirit.**
  - Let's respond by submitting to the Spirit and working toward unity with other believers.
- **Believers in Christ are being built by the Spirit into God's dwelling place.**
  - Let's respond by walking by the Spirit as we face temptations and trials.
