<sup>4</sup> As you come to him, a living stone rejected by men but in the sight of God chosen and precious, <sup>5</sup> you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. <sup>6</sup> For it stands in Scripture:

They Came...

➤ The Red Sea Crossing is Israel's conversion

"You have seen what I did to the Egyptians and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to Myself."

Exodus 19:4



## They Came...

"The Israelites are not to keep the law in order for God to save them. They have already been saved; God has brought them out of Egypt. The law he now gives is the subsequent stage in Israel's developing relationship with God. It is what is expected of a people *already* redeemed."
