A Faithful Walk as God's People

- 1) Remember that God keeps His promises.
Uncertainty (in our minds) does not mean that God's promises are failing.
- 2) Meet God in His Word and He will give you wisdom for life.
- 3) Remember the greatest promise of God is His presence. [Christ is God with us.]

Joshua 1 and 23

- 1] Remember the Lord's Promises... Have faith. (1:6; 23:3-5)
- 2] Hold on to the Lord's Word. (1:7; 23:6)
- 3] Hold on to life in the Lord. (1:8; 23:8)
- 4] Hold on to your love for the Lord. (1:9; 23:11)

Joshua 1:6 and 23:3-5

[1:6] Be strong and courageous, for you shall cause this people to inherit the land that I swore to their fathers to give them.

[23:3-5] And you have seen all that the LORD your God has done to all these nations for your sake, for it is the LORD your God who has fought for you. [4] Behold, I have allotted to you as an inheritance for your tribes those nations that remain, along with all the nations that I have already cut off, from the Jordan to the Great Sea in the west. [5] The LORD your God will push them back before you and drive them out of your sight. And you shall possess their land, just as the LORD your God promised you. (ESV)

Remember the Lord's Promises... Have faith.

Joshua 1:7 and 23:6

[1:7] Only be strong and very courageous, being careful to do according to all the law that Moses my servant commanded you. Do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may have good success wherever you go.

[23:6] Therefore, be very strong to keep and to do all that is written in the Book of the Law of Moses, turning aside from it neither to the right hand nor to the left,

Hold on to the Lord's Word.

Joshua 1:8 and 23:8

[1:8] This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

[23:8] but you shall cling to the LORD your God just as you have done to this day.

Hold on to life in the Lord.

Joshua 1:9 and 23:11

[1:9] Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.”

[23:11] Be very careful, therefore, to love the LORD your God.

Hold on to your love for the Lord.

1. Remember that God's promises are ultimately a promise of His presence.

- God does not just bless us with life and other tangible blessings. He promises to be with us. Our great inheritance is not a land but the Lord. When come to Christ in faith, we receive the Spirit as God's presence in us.

2. God warns us that we cannot be loyal to Him and compromise in our relationships and desires.

- Some biblical texts helps us see that sin is rebellion, others help us see that it is self-deception, and others help us see that it is compromised love. We love the wrong things too much and then we cannot love the Lord as He deserves.

3. Be strong and courageous by reading God's Word and walking in the wisdom of its teaching.

- Just like Joshua we should be reading and meditating on God's Word so that we can avoid the snares of sin and love God supremely. The Bible is the ongoing Word of God to us so that we can listen to His Word and live by His wisdom.
