¹⁶ But when one turns to the Lord, the veil is removed. ¹⁷ Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. ¹⁸ And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. ¹ Therefore, having this ministry by the mercy of God, we do not lose heart. ² But we have renounced disgraceful, underhanded ways. The Light of the World

Passover (John 2), Sabbath (John 5), a second Passover (John 6), the Feast of Booths (John 7). The Festival of Dedication (aka, Hanukkah) will be mentioned in John 10, a third Passover is described in John 11-13

A Point of Reference

John mentions three different Passovers; therefore, Jesus was teaching for at least 3 years as He travelled around the region of the Sea of Galilee and Judea.


A Point of Structure

The festivals mentioned could have a way of binding certain chapters together into loosely collected thematic elements.


A Point of Theology

The Festivals remind the people of God's involvement with them all along. They served as physical manifestations of the spiritual connection they have with Yahweh their God.



...Look to the Lamb!


