

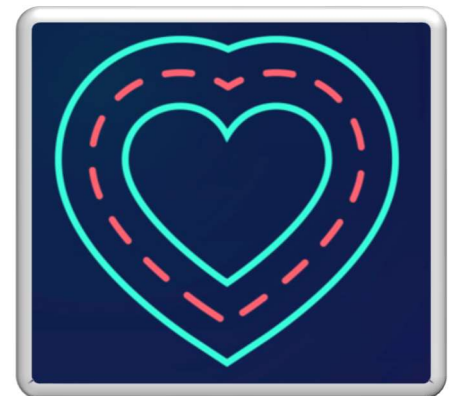

(chapter 1, verses 18-27)

v. 18 - the word of truth  
v. 21 - the implanted word  
v. 22 - but be doers of the word  
v. 25 - the perfect law, the law of liberty  
v. 27 - religion that is pure and undefiled

v. 18 - firstfruits of His creatures  
v. 20 - the righteousness of God  
v. 27 - pure and undefiled before God

v. 20 - the anger of man  
v. 22 - hearers only, deceiving yourselves  
v. 24 - goes away and at once forgets  
v. 26 - thinks he's religious but...deceives
