The love of Christ in which we stand

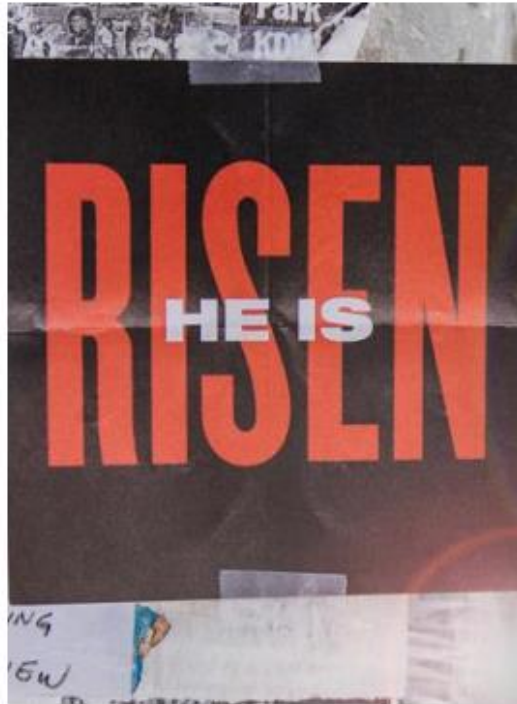

Unto the shore the rock of Christ

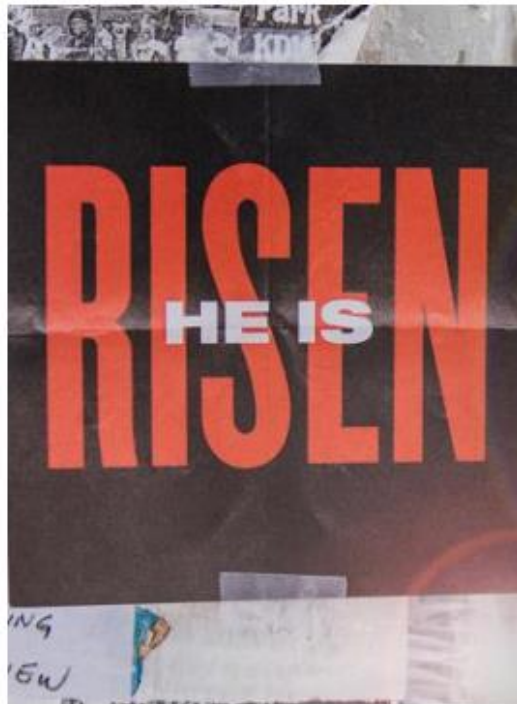
