Our Key Idea:

The church is a believing community of love that acts and reacts with thanksgiving for God's saving work.

Or in Paul's words:

Colossians 3:17- And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. (ESV)

Our text: Colossians 1:3–8

Giving Thanks to God in Prayer (v.3)

Giving thanks to God results in praising Him and praying for others:

Colossians 1:3- We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you,

Our thanksgiving to God is a part of our praise to Him as the one who gives good things and does good in our midst.

Giving Thanks to God in Prayer (v.3)

In v.3, 4, and 8, we see the Triune nature of God results in praise and prompts our prayers for others in the church.

- (v.3) God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ
- (v.4) faith in <u>Christ Jesus</u>
- (v.8) love in the Spirit

Our union with God occurs as we have faith in the Son, Jesus. The Holy Spirit then seals us in this life with God and in a love relationship with other believers, as a family.

Giving Thanks for Other Believers (v.4-5)

We share in the new life in Christ which is marked with Faith, Love, and Hope:

Col. 1:4- since we heard of your <u>faith in Christ Jesus</u> and of the <u>love that you have for all the saints</u>, [5] because of the <u>hope laid up for you in heaven</u>. Of this you have heard before in the word of the truth, the gospel,

Faith- Our faith is in Jesus Christ and His finished work on our behalf.

Love- Our new life in Christ not only results in a new love for God but also in a new love for His people, the church.

Hope- Our hope is our new life in Christ much of which is still hidden in this present life.

Giving Thanks for Other Believers (v.4-5)

The new life in Christ is marked with Faith, Love, and Hope:

Faith- Colossians 2:12–13: [12] having been buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the powerful working of God, who raised him from the dead. [13] And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses,

Love- Colossians 3:12–14: [12] Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, [13] bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. [14] And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.

Hope- Colossians 3:3–4: [3] For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. [4] When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.

The True Work of the Gospel (v.6-7)

Three keys to understanding the work of the gospel, God's true word:

#1- The gospel bears fruit and increases. Because the gospel is embedded in God's true word, it is active and living. The gospel changes lives.

He is a faithful minister of Christ on your behalf

Three keys to understanding the work of the gospel, God's true word:

#2- The gospel is grounded in God's grace and God's truth. Through the gospel sinners recognize the truth that God is holy, and we are separated from Him by our sin. The gospel also delivers the good news that God graciously saves humble, repentant sinners.

Three keys to understanding the work of the gospel, God's true word:

#3- The gospel is to be proclaimed by those who believe it. Once our lives are changed by the gospel, then we become servants/ ministers of the gospel for others.

The Spirit Produces Love (v.8)

Col. 1:8- and has made known to us your love in the Spirit.

Paul says that the Spirit produces love within the church for each other. This love for each other causes us to live in community with each other.

Also, in Romans 15:30, this love in the Spirit also motivates our prayers for each other. Our community together is marked with thanksgiving and prayer.

Romans 15:30- [30] I appeal to you, brothers, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to strive together with me in your prayers to God on my behalf,
