2 Chronicles 6 – In Review

vv. 1-11 = The transient is made permanent.	Incarnate Son of God
vv. 12-17 = God “keeps” the Davidic Covenant.	Covenant Fulfilled
vv. 18-21 = The Temple: where Heaven meets earth.	Cross= Forever
vv. 22-23 = Obey Torah by loving your neighbor.	Evidence of Faith
vv. 24-25 = Victory is found where worship abounds.	Holy Habits
vv. 26-27 = God “answers” with healing rains.	All things “new”

Jonah's Example

Jonah prays and validates the provision offered in Solomon's prayer. Here is an example of someone relenting, turning back to God and turning away from the captivity caused by their sinfulness, trusting in the LORD regardless of any circumstantial change.

Penitential prayer is essential for attitudinal resolution

“But I with the voice of thanksgiving will sacrifice to You; what I have vowed I will pay. Salvation belongs to the LORD!”

Jonah 2:9

When we know the LORD, His power and presence, His holiness and favor, a desire should fill our souls in worship as we give our lives to Him.

By the end of Solomon's prayer, the people take up the priestly chant themselves. This serves as a confirmation of what the Levitical priests were already saying about God before the prayer. Now the people are demonstrating a common belief, reinforcing and confirming their own faith after the prayer.

And all the Levitical singers... when the song was raised, with trumpets and cymbals and other musical instruments, in praise to the LORD, "For He is good, for His steadfast love endures forever..." 2 Chronicles 5:12-13

Solomon dedicates the Temple for its function within the national religious expression of the sacrificial system, while the nation responds with the same kind of dedication in honoring the God who is represented by the Temple with its accompanying sacrifices.

...he sent the people away to their homes, joyful and glad of heart for the prosperity that the LORD had granted to David and to Solomon and to Israel His people.
