# Surrendering to Christ | 1 Peter

A Living Hope (Part 2)

1 Peter 1:1-9

"First Peter was written to Christians who were experiencing various forms of persecution, men and women whose stand for Jesus Christ made them aliens and strangers in the midst of a pagan society. Peter exhorted these Christians to steadfast endurance and exemplary behavior. The warmth of his expressions combined with his practical instructions make this epistle a unique source of encouragement for all believers who live in conflict with their culture."

"Those who read 1 Peter are encouraged to lift their eyes from present problems and trials and behold the vistas provided by an eternal perspective. For though believers may for a while suffer grief in trials, they wait for an inheritance that can never perish, spoil, or fade."

"Our hope is anchored in the past: Jesus rose! Our hope remains in the present: Jesus lives! Our hope is completed in the future: Jesus is coming! (1:5, 7, 13)."

"Peter used a triple word picture to describe this inheritance. Our inheritance can never perish, spoil or fade. These three verbal adjectives indicate that the inheritance is untouched by death, unstained by evil, and unimpaired by time. Our inheritance is death-proof, sin-proof, and time-proof."

"The wonder of our hope is that the same power of God that keeps our inheritance also keeps us. We are shielded until the great day when our salvation will be revealed. The word shielded means 'kept under guard'. It is used of protective custody. God has put us under arrest, as it were, to keep us safe for his day. Pilgrims we may be, but the cloud of God's power that leads us in the way becomes a wall of fire about us."

"...the solid ore must be melted, requiring a temperature of 1,900 degrees Fahrenheit. When the gold is melted, the impurities rise to the surface, where they are skimmed off or burned off. A goldsmith knows the gold is ready to cast when the liquid gold becomes mirror-like and he can see his face reflected in the surface. The parallel in a believer's life is obvious. Through the refining heat of trials, we as followers of Jesus Christ grow spiritually and thus reflect more of Christ's character in our lives."

"Peter marvels at the love of those who have never seen Christ (1:8); his message of the living hope in Christ has its background in his despair at the crucifixion, and his joy in fellowship with the risen Christ. His emphasis on humility has poignant meaning after the boasting that preceded his fall. The Lord had charged him to tend His flock, and he passes that admonition on to other under-shepherds."

"The believer is saved; he is being saved daily (through sanctification); and he will be saved completely when Christ returns (Rom. 8:15-25). The end (completion, perfection) of our faith will be the complete salvation of the believer (v. 9), who will inherit a new body."
