¹⁶ Then those who feared the LORD spoke with one another. The LORD paid attention and heard them, and a book of remembrance was written before him of those who feared the LORD and esteemed his name.

vv. 1-11 = What was transient is now permanent.


vv. 12-17 = God “keeps” Covenant; He is faithful.

Elijah taken up by whirlwind into heaven (2 Kgs. 2:11)


