

## **The Spirit of Antisemitism – How the End-Time Hatred for Israel Reveals the Anti-Christ Agenda**

As the Last Days approach, there is an increased obsession with Israel as both political and cultural tensions rise.

In the world overtaken with globalism and unity under man-made systems, Israel stands as a reminder that they are God's chosen people, a chosen land, with an unchanging covenant.

**2 Chronicles 6:6** *“But I have chosen Jerusalem that My name may be there, and I have chosen David to be over My people Israel.”*

**Psalms 132:13-14** *“For the Lord has chosen Zion; He has desired it for His dwelling place: ‘This is My resting place forever; here I will dwell, for I have desired it’”*

**This is not a geopolitical statement –  
It is a prophetic statement from the Creator of the Universe!**

Scripture makes it clear Israel is God's timepiece, and Jerusalem is the trigger point for the final shaking of nations.

Antisemitism is far more than just a form of racism or ethnic hatred – it is spiritual rebellion at its core!

- It's not only the rejection of a people – it is the rejection of the God who chose them, the covenants He established, and the Messiah who came through them.
- The rising global hostility toward Israel is not accidental or simply political – it is a signpost of the Babylonian anti-Christ system that is advancing.
- The Babylonian spirit is the counterfeit kingdom – and Israel represents the heartbeat of God's eternal Kingdom.

From the beginning, Israel holds a central role in God's redemptive plan:

- God called Abraham to bless him and make of him a great nation/people to be a blessing to all the nations of the world through his lineage.
- God raised up the prophets, the promises, and the Messiah who came through Israel.
- The story of God's redemption plan does not end with the cross of Jesus Christ but reveals that Israel has a prophetic destiny to be fulfilled when Jesus Christ returns to earth.

- It's not Washington, DC or any other capital of the world where Jesus will return, it will be Jerusalem.

This alone is why the enemy hates Jerusalem and the Jews so much. The rage against Israel is ultimately rage against the return of Jesus.

This explains why we are witnessing a disturbing, escalating trend of antisemitism in this generation.

Satan knows his time is short, so he has accelerated his attacks in an attempt to discredit Israel, and even God Himself. He knows if he can succeed in destroying Israel he can conquer and control the world, causing himself to be worshiped.

But the Lord has news for satan: **Jeremiah 31:35-36**

*Thus says the Lord,  
Who gives the sun for a light by day,  
The ordinances of the moon and the stars for a light by night,  
Who disturbs the sea,  
And its waves roar  
(The Lord of hosts is His name):*

*<sup>36</sup>“If those ordinances depart  
From before Me, says the Lord,  
Then the seed of Israel shall also cease  
From being a nation before Me forever.”*

The Jews did not cease from being a nation through their captivity in Babylon, nor through their destruction by the Romans; they continue a distinct nation and people to this day, though scattered throughout the nations of the world.

Christ will have a seed to serve Him as long as the sun and moon endure; His church shall continue to the end of the world; it is built on a rock; and the gates of hell cannot prevail against it.

The current rise in antisemitism is a reemergence of a demonic agenda that has been at work since Pharoah tried to destroy Israel's children, since Haman plotted genocide in Persia [Iran today], and since Hitler's Holocaust.

**Psalm 83:4** *They have said, “Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation, That the name of Israel may be remembered no more.”*

- That spirit is not dead, but active in terrorist regimes, through global media, and, tragically, even in some Christian churches that teach replacement theology.

It appears in many talks of Israel that they no longer have a right to exist as we hear of upheavals through college campuses, negative reporting from media outlets, even statements from government officials who are increasingly siding with the narratives that demonize Israel while excusing evil.

**This is not political confusion – it is prophetic blindness!**

Revelation 12 paints a picture of this spiritual war:

A dragon, representing satan, tries to destroy a woman, symbolic of Israel who gives birth to a male child – Christ.

When the dragon fails, he turns his rage toward the woman and the rest of her offspring – those who keep God’s commandments and hold the testimony of Jesus.

- Both Israel and the Church are targets of satan’s fury:
- His hatred is twofold:
  1. Against the natural seed – Israel
  2. The Spiritual seed – the Church

As the church, we must be wide awake to these dynamics which are labeled “Replacement Theology” – the false belief the Church has replaced Israel in God’s plan. Replacement Theology lays the groundwork for the antisemitic attitude growing in the Church today.

Romans 11 says the grafted-in branches [Gentiles] are not to boast against the natural branches [Israel].

There are current day “influencers” who lend their voices to the antisemitic rhetoric!

- The danger in what they are saying is it leads many **believers** who don’t study and understand and don’t have a biblical world view, to accept their false views.

We as the church, must anchor ourselves in the Word of the Lord – not politics or cultural commentary.

**We must be Spirit led and Word centered.**

Antisemitism is not just an opinion – it is alignment with the spirit of Anti-Christ.

The promise of **Genesis 12:3** still stands: *“I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you.”*

In the future, standing with Israel will become even more costly, but we must not shrink back.

The nations are now aligning, the hatred towards Israel is rising; but Israel will not be destroyed.

We must be bold, speak the truth even though unpopular.

**Zechariah 12:1-3**      *The burden of the word of the Lord against Israel. Thus says the Lord, who stretches out the heavens, lays the foundation of the earth, and forms the spirit of man within him: <sup>2</sup>“Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of drunkenness to all the surrounding peoples, when they lay siege against Judah and Jerusalem. <sup>3</sup>And it shall happen on that day that I will make Jerusalem a very heavy stone for all people; all who would heave it away will surely be cut in pieces, though all nations of the earth are gathered against it.”*

May the Lord help the church in America and the U.S. government not to turn their backs on Israel, or the curses will come upon us.

Antisemitism is always a sign that persecution is on the horizon, not just for the Jewish people but for all who follow the Jewish Messiah – Yeshua.

The same spirit that hates Israel hates the Church.

The radical Muslim cry is: “Down with America the big satan and Israel the little satan; both of whom must be overcome by Jihad.”

What starts as cultural or political hostility toward the Jewish people eventually bleeds over into a full-blown attack on everyone who stands for God, Truth, and Righteousness.

We are already experiencing effects of antisemitism:

1. The marginalization of biblical values
2. The labeling of truth as hate speech
3. The social canceling of anyone who won't bow to the gods of this age

The pressure is rising and many believers are not ready for what's coming ahead. The Word gives an insight of what to expect: **2 Timothy 3:12** *Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution.*

- This is not a question of **IF**, but one of **WHEN**.

We must prepare ourselves, not in fear, but in faith. HOW?

1. Fortifying our minds, bodies, and spirits.
2. Make your decision now that you'll not bow to Babylon spirit.
3. Make your decision now that you'll not deny the Lord Jesus.
4. Make your decision now that you'll not shrink back, even if it costs you everything.

**The days of casual Christianity are over – the middle ground is vanishing!**

(There never should have been a middle ground in your life anyway!)

Realize – **John 15:18** *If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before it hated you.*

Take courage – **John 16:33** *“These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation, but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.”*

**The Church was born in persecution, and it shines in persecution!**

**Now is the time to focus on preparing yourself in these vital ways:**

1. Mentally – **Romans 12:2** *And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.*
  - Feed yourself on what edifies your spirit; watch what you read and who you listen to, follow on media, and hang with.
  - Bring your flesh under subjection to the Spirit; align your thoughts with Heaven's goals and promises.
2. Physically – Be stewards of the physical life the Lord gave you.
  - Our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit [1 Corinthians 6:19] carrying the presence of the Lord.
  - Prepare yourself physically to be in the best shape you can be to fulfill your destiny in the Lord.
  - Know how to sustain yourself and your family when challenging times come – prepare now, not after a crisis begins!

3. Spiritually – Shallow Christianity or faith will not survive the difficult days coming.

- Your secret place with the Lord is essential to developing a strong spiritual wellbeing.
- Public ministry matters little if there is no private intimacy. You won't have the character to carry the anointing.

**No Matter What – Stand Strong:**

From Pharoah to Haman to Hitler the anti-Christ spirit has been a constant threat throughout history –

**The enemy hates God's covenant people whether it's Jew or Gentile!**
