

How is the Believer Empowered by the Holy Spirit to Be a Witness?**Part 1**

Description: If you want to have a dynamic ministry, you must cultivate a deep dependence upon God through a relationship with the Holy Spirit. In this class, Evangelist Jean-Luc Trachsel takes us through the Word of God to teach us that the Holy Spirit is God Himself. We can trust His leading. He wants to use us to advance the Kingdom, but that starts with a genuine relationship with Him.

Together with Daniel Kolenda, he also launched and co-chaired the Global Evangelist Alliance (GEA) under the banner of Empowered21. Internationally recognized speaker, he travelled over the five continents to more than eighty nations and shared the Gospel in all kind of situations and circumstances. Jean-Luc leads his ministry with enthusiasm, passion and wisdom. In his autobiography “dans les coulisses d’un miracle” he explains with authenticity how he lives the power of God in his daily life, during meetings or events. With humility, he also shares how God carried him through a difficult two-year break, after suffering from a burn-out.

Key Points:

- Luke 4:18-19 is a prophecy that was given by the Prophet Isaiah hundreds of years before the coming of Jesus. It gets fulfilled as Jesus is baptized.
- The Holy Spirit will bring you to places you don’t really want to go—even to desert places. Jesus was led by the Holy Spirit into the desert.
- A desert season is not for eternity—only for a short season.
- God wants to bring you to a place of abundance—a place where there is a manifestation of His power and fruit.
- The key to bearing much fruit is to spend time with Jesus. You cannot have access to Jesus without the help of the Holy Spirit
- The Holy Spirit is God Himself.

Notes:

We see three things in Luke 4:1.

1. Jesus is first baptized in the Holy Spirit
2. He was then led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil
3. He gets empowered by the Holy Spirit to start His ministry

Not only did Jesus come to this earth to seek those who are lost. Not only did Jesus go from place to place, healing the sick, casting out demons, doing great things. Not only did He fulfil His destiny by going to the cross. But Jesus also came on this earth to open up supernatural realities so that we are able to have the precious Holy Spirit—the same Holy Spirit who came upon Jesus.

The Holy Spirit is God. He is:

Omnipresent, omniscient, omnipotent

He teaches us the deep things of the Lord

He reminds us. He testifies. He convicts us.

He leads us. He speaks to us and hears us.

He glorifies Jesus. He commands. He sends.

He prevents. He warns. He helps us. He intercedes.

He thinks. He probes and searches. He knows everything.

He brings the tangible presence of God into our lives.

He gives the capacity to walk with God.

He helps us understand the Word of God

He transforms us. He makes us know justice and mercy.

He allows to experience the peace and joy of the Kingdom.

He transforms our desert into a fruitful garden.

As Evangelists, we need to spend time in prayer. We need to go to our knees to cry out to the Lord to save this generation.

If you are new to ministry, the Holy Spirit is the best adviser. He is the advocate, the spirit of truth.

The Holy Spirit is a person who has emotion. The Holy Spirit has a will. He has desire. As a person, He wants to spend time with you.

The Holy Spirit is willing to reveal to you the deep, profound things from the Lord. His main job is to reveal Jesus. He brings fresh anointing to you every morning. He wants to help you fulfill your ministry, to fulfill your destiny.

It's the Holy Spirit who leads you to the harvest field. It is the Holy Spirit who gives you the tools needed to preach the Gospel and to be effective in the harvest field where God sends you.

The good news is that the Holy Spirit is willing to use everybody who is willing to be used by Him.
