Key Points:

- Walking in a supernatural lifestyle comes from living in an intimate relationship with Jesus.
- We must see the same way He sees—we need to gain His perspective.
- Jesus was born into this world fully God and fully man. He ministered as a man who relied upon God's empowerment. We are to model exactly what Jesus did.
- We must see that Jesus paid the price on the cross to make us sons and daughters. If we do not understand this, we will live as slaves to sin.
- When Jesus was baptized, the Holy Spirit descended on Him, rested, and remained.
- Because the Holy Spirit has been poured out, the same works that Jesus did are fully available to any believer who is baptized in the Holy Spirit.

Notes:

When you were born again, you were equipped to live a supernatural lifestyle.

Your full potential isn't realized and recognized until you can see through His eyes.

Being still in the presence of the Lord is the essential ingredient to supernatural witnessing.

The Bible says to be filled with the fullness of God is to know the love of God that's in Christ Jesus.

I need to behold the Lamb on a consistent basis. Beholding the Lamb means that my gaze is upon Jesus at all times.

Jesus was born into this world fully God and fully man. However, in order for Jesus to accomplish what He did, it had to be done in the strength of a man. Divinity can never be taken away from Jesus. But He laid it aside and became a man.

The same Holy Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in us. We are to be imitators of God.

Jesus died a criminal's death on the cross so that you and I could go free—clear, without guilt, shame, and condemnation.

If you're not “God-fident” about who God has created you to be, or who He says you are, you won't witness. If you're more focused on sin and why you're always going to miss it, you won't minister to people.

The Bible tells us that Jesus grew in both wisdom and stature. He grew in both with man and with God.

Jesus couldn't baptize John because His baptism of the Holy Spirit wouldn't be given until after Jesus was crucified, resurrected, and went to be at the right hand of the Father.

Jesus told John to baptize Him because it was necessary for righteousness to be fulfilled. The fulfillment of righteousness means the completion.

Jesus is led by the Spirit into the wilderness—He is not led by the devil.

Jesus came out of the wilderness filled with the Holy Ghost resting upon Him. He had been anointed.

God wants to make you a house of prayer where supernatural works flow through you. The Holy Spirit resting upon you and remaining is what you need.
