

Reclaim a Generation Prayer Points:

Tips for Prayer Walking:

1. **Worship** – proclaim the Name of Jesus Christ as Lord on the school grounds. If you can, without being a distraction – sing softly to exalt the Lord.
2. **Warfare** – This is a spiritual battle – resist confusion, strife, thoughts in your mind causing it to wander and be distracted, or this isn't doing any good. **PRESS THROUGH** and take authority over the enemy.
3. **Welcome** – Invite Holy Spirit's transforming presence to permeate the school grounds, building, class rooms, hallways, locker rooms.
4. **Don't draw attention to yourself** - you don't have to be loud or demonstrative with your actions.
5. **Pray with your eyes open** – listen for God's cues, even though you have scriptures and prayers.
6. **Pray together in unity** – allow each to pray as they are led.
7. **Pray with scripture** – you will be praying the Lords will if you pray the Word.
8. **Pray as led by Holy Spirit** – He will give you specifics for that school or students or teachers or administration.

What to pray for:

9. **Pray for God's glory** – that He would be honored on this property by administration, teachers, students and family; physical safety and protection from any who would do harm.

10. **Pray for God's Kingdom** – pray resisting darkness and deception; welcoming the Light of God's Kingdom of Truth and Righteousness.
11. **Pray for Reconciliation** – pray declaring as ministers of reconciliation that students, families and teachers be reconciled to God. Peace among all who attend this school.
12. **Pray for the release of God's presence on the campus** – Holy Spirit leads all students, teachers, administration in the light of His love, mercy, and truth. Claim all for the Kingdom of God.
13. **Pray for School Boards to have God fearing and honoring members to protect the students from anti-Christ ideologies** being allowed in the school system through curriculum and classroom setting.

Scriptures to use:

1. Truth in the Curriculum: Colossians 2:8 “Be careful not to let anyone rob you of this faith through a shallow and misleading philosophy. Such a person follow human traditions and the world's way of doing things rather than following Christ.”

Noah Webster quote: “The education of youth should be watched with the most scrupulous attention...it lays the foundations on which both law and gospel rest for success.”

2. Physical & emotional health and safety: Isaiah 54:17 “No weapon that is formed against you will prosper; and every tongue that rises against you in judgment you shall condemn...”
 - Rebuke the spirit of fear off teachers & students from all the Covid, masks and other issues weighing on the minds of people.
 - We declare there will be NO active shooter incidents on the property we are praying for.
3. Truth and Clarity on Gender and Sexuality issues: Gen. 1:27 “God created mankind in His own image, in the image of God He created them; male and female He created them.”

- Courage for students and faculty to stand for the truth and not be bullied about gender issues and will speak the truth in love.
4. Taking the school system back for true education purposes and not ideology brain washing:
John 8:3 “You will know the truth and the truth will set you free.”
Isa. 59:14 “So justice is driven back, and righteousness stands at a distance, truth has stumbled in the streets, honesty cannot enter.” BUT, WE CALL
 RIGHTEOUSNESS AND TRUTH TO RE-ENTER THE SCHOOL SYSTEM.
 5. Home life: Praying for the single parent home, the home where the grandparents are raising grandchildren, homes where divorce, abuse, violence is occurring.
Malachi 4:6: “He will turn the hearts of the parents to their children, and the hearts of the children to their parents; or else I will come and strike the land with total destruction.”
Eph. 6:4 “Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.”
 6. Teachers, support staff, principals and administrators, school boards and community support:
James 3:1 “Not many of you should become teachers, my fellow believers, because you know that we who teach will be judged more strictly.” Father, give us more Godly teachers who will promote Your ways to the kids and youth.
Hebrews 13:16 “Do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased.” The support staff and aides are there to serve in the spirit of servanthood.
1 Timothy 2:1-2 “First of all, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way.”
Matt 18:5-6 “Whoso shall receive a little child in My name receives Me. But whoever offends on of these little ones which believes in Me, it would be better that a millstone were hung on their neck and they were drowned in the depths of the sea.”
 7. The Church: We are called to shift the atmosphere from spiritual darkness to Light.

Isa: 44:3-4 “For I will pour out water on the thirsty land and streams on the dry ground; I will pour out My Spirit on your offspring and My blessing on your descendants; and they will spring up among the grass, like poplars by streams of water.”

8. Identity and Purpose in God’s Design:

- Lack of identity is the cause of much of the gender confusion and general disorder in people’s lives.

Col. 1:9-10 “We have ceased to pray for you and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so that you will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please Him in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God.”

9. Praying to **RECLAIM A GENERATION:**

We must have an invasion of prayer power and God’s Spirit to reclaim the school system to bring a reformation and transformation to culture. There must be a Godly generation that arises equipped and skilled in way that our culture will listen to and respond.

Isa. 61:3b-4 “They shall build up the ancient ruins; they shall raise up the former devastations; they shall repair the ruined cities, the devastations of many generations.”

Jer. 31:16-17 “This is what the Lord says, restrain your voice from weeping and your eyes from tears, for your work will be rewarded, declares the Lord. They will return from the land of the enemy. So there is hope for your descendants, declares the Lord.”

Isa. 54:13 “And all your children shall be disciples by the Lord and obedient to His will, and great shall be the peace and undisturbed composure of your children.”

Isa. 49:25 “For thus says the Lord: even the captives of the mighty shall be taken, and the prey of the tyrant be rescued, for I will contend with those who contend with you, and I will save your children.”
