

Conduct Requirements for Co-op Membership

1. Register online, agree to our Statement of Faith (or to respect it if you don't agree), understand and agree to our Conduct Requirements for Membership, and pay the co-op fee of \$10 per student, per semester.
2. The term for a membership shall be one year ending August 1st each year.
3. The name, reputation, and glory of God will be protected and honored at all times.
4. Field trips and activities for homeschoolers are planned and organized by the leadership team and/or volunteer members. They are announced on our Facebook group page and sign-ups and any payment due will be done through the church app and website. **Each participant must assume any and all risk of physical injury or any other injury that could result from any field trips, activities, and events.**
5. Parents are held responsible for the behavior of their children and any children they bring with them at all times. Parents are expected to be engaged in their children's activities. All event attendees will demonstrate a high model of cooperation, courtesy, and respect for host facility, instructors, adults, and each other. **Any facility damage is the responsibility of the family that caused the damage. This includes all costs and repairs needed.**
6. All members will dress appropriately, neatly, and **modestly**. No short shorts, no two-piece bikini bathing suits, and no bra straps, underwear or bellies showing. No inappropriate text or graphics on t-shirts.
7. Members agree to wholeheartedly, faithfully, and **punctually** participate in scheduled support group activities.
8. Membership directories shall not be used for any business and/or advertising purposes.
9. If relational issues arise, according to Matthew 18:15-17, members will work things out in a Biblical and spiritual manner with forgiveness, grace, and love.
10. Members will not: act in any way that would bring disrespect upon the name of the LORD, the church, or the group, have repeated tardiness, be disobedient, disrespect authority or property, fail to control attitude or anger, lie, use inappropriate language or gestures, steal, cheat, or smoke anywhere near or in the site of members or children.

Repeated or blatant disregard for the above stated requirements will be addressed by the leadership team with the intent to resolve the situation in a Godly manner. In the event that resolution is not possible, we reserve the right to terminate membership.

We have read the Conduct Requirements for membership with our family. We all understand and agree to the above standards and policies and will uphold them to the best of our ability.
