Drodzy Bracia i Siostry w Chrystusie,

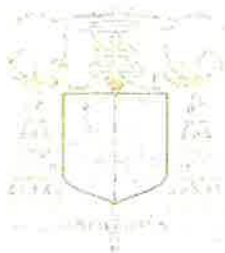
