Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Daily, we hear heartbreaking stories of suffering from Gaza. So many innocent victims, including those who belong to Christian communities, face violence, dire living conditions, and hunger. Our Holy Father Pope Leo has said "Gaza is starving," as he called for a cease fire. In a particular way, the faces of Gaza's hungry children make an indelible impression on our hearts.

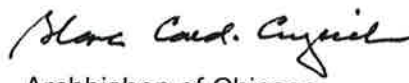
Perhaps we feel helpless to address this complex story that involves international players. There is, however, a pathway for us to respond. Two very reliable agencies of the Catholic Church are already there providing vital emergency humanitarian relief and medical and psychological care for the sick, malnourished, and wounded. They are the Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA) and Catholic Relief Services (CRS).

On the weekend of September 6-7, the parishes of the Archdiocese of Chicago will take up a special collection that will be promptly forwarded to CNEWA and CRS.

Whatever you can give will go far to alleviate the suffering of our brothers and sisters in the Middle East. I know the compassion and generosity of the people of the Archdiocese of Chicago. In the name of all those who will benefit from your support, I thank you.

Finally, let us pray urgently for the gift of peace in our wounded world, a peace which only the Lord can give.

Muchas víctimas inocentes, incluidas aquellas que pertenecen a comunidades cristianas, enfrentan violencia, terribles condiciones de vida y hambre. Nuestro Santo Padre, el papa León, dijo: "Gaza se muere de hambre", mientras pidió un alto al fuego. De manera particular, los rostros de los niños hambrientos de Gaza dejan una impresión indeleble en nuestros corazones.

Quizás nos sentimos incapaces de abordar esta compleja historia que involucra a actores internacionales. Hay, sin embargo, un camino para que nosotros podamos responder. Dos agencias muy confiables de la Iglesia católica ya están allí brindando ayuda humanitaria vital de emergencia y atención médica y psicológica para los enfermos, desnutridos y heridos. Ellas son la Asociación Católica para el Bienestar del Cercano Oriente (CNEWA, por sus siglas en inglés) y Catholic Relief Services (CRS).

El fin de semana del 6 y 7 de septiembre, las parroquias de la Arquidiócesis de Chicago realizarán una colecta especial que se enviará con prontitud a CNEWA y CRS.

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Drogie Siostry i drodzy Bracia w Chrystusie,

Każdego dnia słyszymy poruszające do głębi serc historie o cierpieniu wielu osób z Gazy. Tak wiele niewinnych ofiar, w tym członków wspólnot chrześcijańskich, doświadcza przemocy, skrajnie trudnych warunków życia i głodu. Nasz Ojciec Święty, papież Leon, wzywając do zawieszenia broni powiedział: „Gaza głoduje”. W szczególnie sposób twarze głodnych dzieci w Gazie pozostawiają niezatarte wrażenia w naszych sercach.

Być może czujemy się bezradni wobec tej złożonej sytuacji, w którą zaangażowani są międzynarodowi gracze. Istnieje jednak droga, byśmy mogli odpowiedzieć na te cierpienia. Dwie bardzo wiarygodne agencje Kościoła katolickiego są już tam obecne, niosąc niezbędną, pilną pomoc humanitarną oraz opiekę medyczną i psychologiczną dla chorych, niedożywionych i rannych. Są to Katolickie Stowarzyszenie Pomocy dla Bliskiego Wschodu (Catholic Near East Welfare - Association CNEWA) oraz Katolickie Służby Pomocy (Catholic Relief Services - CRS).

Podczas weekendu 6–7 września parafie Archidiecezji Chicago przeprowadzą specjalną kolektę, która zostanie niezwłocznie przekazana do CNEWA i CRS.

Bez względu na wysokość daru, Państwa wsparcie znacząco przyczyni się do niesienia ulgi cierpiącym na Bliskim Wschodzie. Wiem do jak wielkiej hojności i współczującej miłości zdolni są wierni Archidiecezji Chicago. Składam serdeczne podziękowania w imieniu wszystkich, którzy skorzystają z Państwa wsparcia.
