This week Thursday we will be celebrating "Thanksgiving." We are all familiar with its history. Our celebration has evolved into sharing a meal with one another and then watch television and/or go shopping.

I would invite all of us to consider what being *THANKFUL* could mean when we look at it from a faith perspective.

DEFINITIONS OF THANKSGIVING IN THE BIBLE:
So, what does it mean to give thanks?

Several Greek and Hebrew words are translated "thanks" and "thanksgiving" in the Bible, but here are the big two.

Hebrew: ydh

This is the main word for thanks in the Old Testament. The concept of thanks comes up 102 times in the Old Testament, and this word is used 72 of those times.

Here's the definition:

Acknowledging what is right about God in praise and thanksgiving (1 Chr. 16:34). It can also mean a right acknowledgment of self before God in confessing sin (Lev. 26:40)[1]

Greek: eucharisteo

Thankfulness comes up 71 times in the New Testament, and most of those instances are this word, or related to this word.

The definition:

To show oneself grateful, to be thankful, to give thanks [...] used in a religious sense with or without reference to God.[2]

My liturgical friends will recognize the word "Eucharist" in this definition. This term comes from Jesus' giving thanks before eating his last supper with the apostles (1 Co 11:24).

However, we will celebrate "Thanksgiving", I invite all of us to become more aware of the God that is present in your life and also in the lives of your families.

Entonces, ¿qué significa dar gracias?

Varias palabras griegas y hebreas se traducen como "gracias" y "acción de gracias" en la Biblia, pero aquí están las dos grandes.

Hebreo: ydh

Esta es la palabra principal para agradecer en el Antiguo Testamento . El concepto de agradecimiento aparece 102 veces en el Antiguo Testamento, y esta palabra se usa 72 de esos tiempos.

Aquí está la definición:

Reconociendo lo que es correcto acerca de Dios en alabanza y acción de gracias (1 Crónicas 16:34). También puede significar un correcto reconocimiento de sí mismo ante Dios al confesar el pecado (Levítico 26:40) (1).

Griego: eucharisteo:

El agradecimiento aparece 71 veces en el Nuevo Testamento , y la mayoría de esas instancias son esta palabra o están relacionadas con esta palabra.

La definición:

Para mostrarse agradecido, ser agradecido, dar gracias [...]
usado en un sentido religioso con o sin referencia a Dios. [2]

Mis amigos litúrgicos reconocerán la palabra "Eucaristía" en esta definición. Este término proviene de las gracias de Jesús antes de comer su última cena con los apóstoles (1 Co 11:24).

Sin embargo, celebraremos "Acción de Gracias", invito a todos a ser más conscientes del Dios que está presente en su vida y también en las vidas de sus familias.

Uznając, co jest słuszne Bogu w chwale i dziękczynieniu (1 Chr 16:34). Może to również oznaczać słuszne uznanie siebie przed Bogiem w wyznaniu grzechu (Lw 26:40) [1]

Grecki: eucharisteo

Wdzięczność pojawia się 71 razy w Nowym Testamencie, a większość z tych przypadków jest to słowo, lub związane z tym słowem.

Definicja:

Pokazać wdzięczność, wdzięczność, podziękowania [...], używane w sensie religijnym z odniesieniem do Boga lub bez niego. [2]

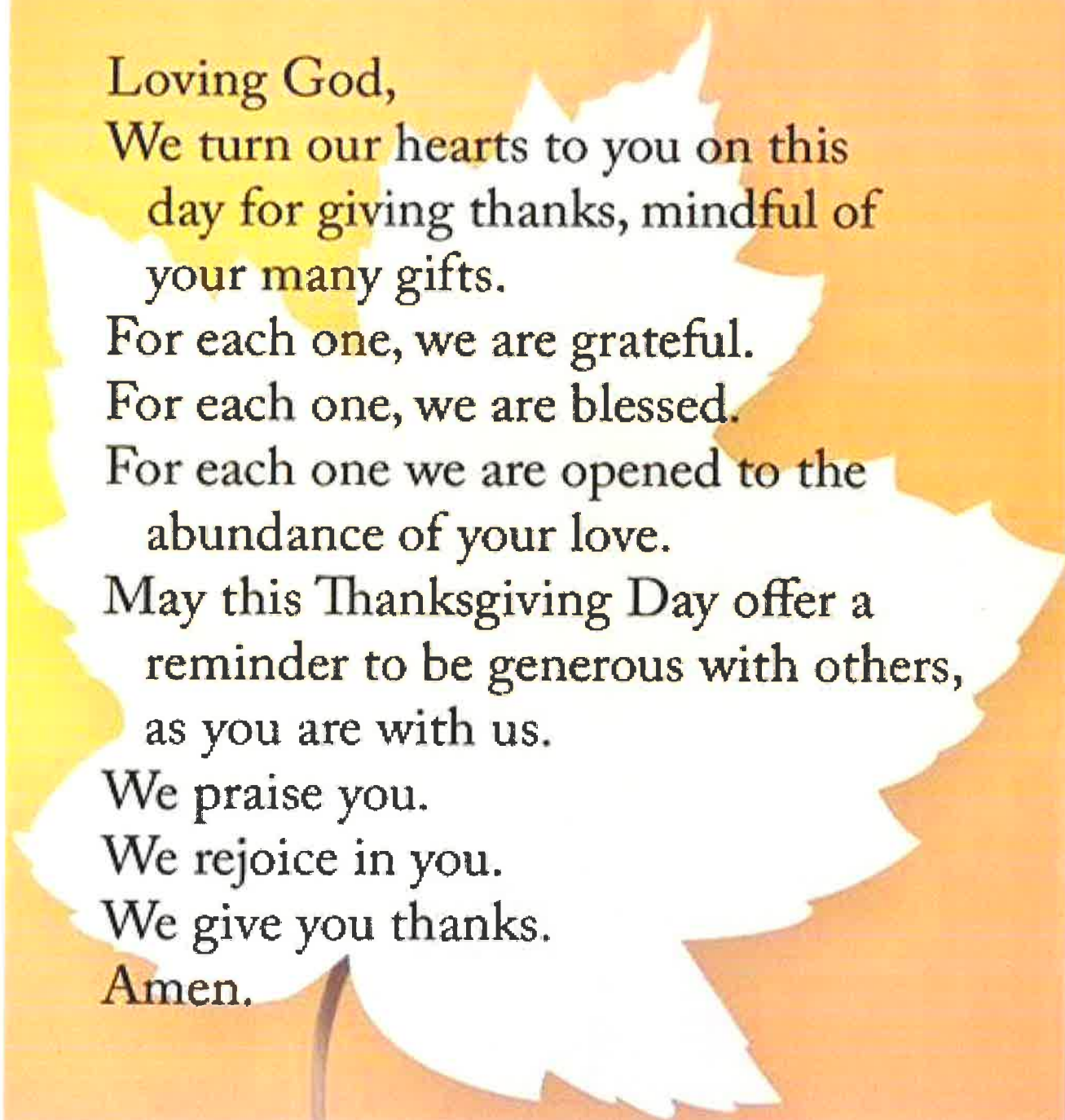
