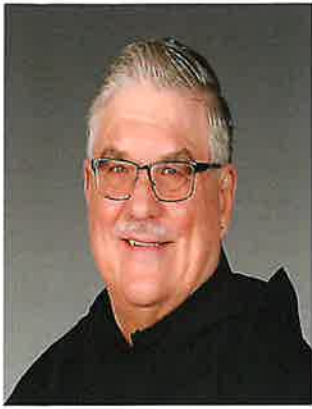

I found this article in my files and thought it would be good to share. This is the last part of the article.

I'm bored

Third, boring people make more boredom occur. Once it occurs, alleviating said boredom usually manifests itself in the vice that affects a person most frequently. For an increasing number of people, it is the consumption of pornography that is their drug of choice.

Don't be a boring person. Keeping things vanilla or beige so as to not offend people, or by striving to be a "nice guy or gal" does not make for a good disciple of Christ. We are called to holiness by God, and this often means shaking things up! Thus, we must take steps to strive to be saintly is the first change in mindset that must occur.

Thus, make the decision not to be boring: do something virtuous and holy to reflect this change in mentality. Go worship the Lord in Divine Liturgy or Mass; if unavailable, go worship Him in Eucharistic Adoration. Get involved with a parish group (ask your parish secretary to help connect you), serve at a local food bank or pantry, or get a group together for a bible study.

I can't get no satisfaction

Satisfaction from viewing pornography is fleeting and degrading for all parties involved. When seeking real satisfaction, we can look towards the clear redemption in Jesus' words in the Gospel account of "The Woman at the Well":

The woman said to him, "Sir, you have no bucket, and the well is deep. Where do you get that living water? Are you greater than our ancestor Jacob, who gave us the well, and with his sons and his flocks drank from it?" Jesus said to her, "Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again, but those who drink of the water that I will give them will never be thirsty. The water that I will give will become in them a spring of water gushing up to eternal life." – John 4: 11-14

It is not wrong to want to be satisfied; it simply matters how you want to do this. It is only in God that we will be ultimately fulfilled. Ask Him for help and He will give you grace to strive for holiness and become the saint God wants you to be.

Attending Mass regularly is necessary for pursuing the satisfaction for which we long. In the liturgy, we encounter God in a profound way, and are given marching orders in how we are to live our lives for God's glory. This includes bringing others to experience this same satisfaction is the natural outflow of our pursuit of holiness (cf. 1 John 1:4). Thus, invite your friends and family to Mass! Even if they may have fallen out of practice, you can be a means of putting them in touch with an experience of God's truth, beauty, and goodness.

Estimados Hermanos/as en Cristo,

Encontré este artículo en mis archivos y pensé que sería bueno compartirlo. Esta es la última parte del artículo.

Estoy aburrido

En tercer lugar, las personas aburridas provocan más aburrimiento. Una vez que esto ocurre, aliviar dicho aburrimiento suele manifestarse en el vicio que más frecuentemente afecta a una persona. Para un número cada vez mayor de personas, el consumo de pornografía es su droga preferida.

No seas una persona aburrida. Mantener las cosas normales o sin complicaciones para no ofender a la gente, o esforzarse por ser un «chico o chica agradable» no te convierte en un buen discípulo de Cristo. Dios nos llama a la santidad, ¡y esto a menudo significa cambiar las cosas! Por lo tanto, debemos dar pasos para esforzarnos por ser santos, que es el primer cambio de mentalidad que debe producirse.

Así pues, toma la decisión de no ser aburrido: haz algo virtuoso y santo para reflejar este cambio de mentalidad. Ve a adorar al Señor en la Divina Liturgia o en la Misa; si no es posible, ve a adorarlo en la Adoración Eucarística. Participa en un grupo parroquial (pide ayuda a la secretaria de tu parroquia para que te ponga en contacto), colabora en un banco de alimentos o despensa local, o forma un grupo para estudiar la Biblia.

No consigo satisfacción

La satisfacción que se obtiene al ver pornografía es efímera y degradante para todas las partes implicadas. Cuando buscamos la satisfacción verdadera, podemos mirar hacia la clara redención en las palabras de Jesús en el relato evangélico de «La mujer en el pozo»:

La mujer le dijo: «Señor, no tienes cubo, y el pozo es profundo. ¿De dónde sacas esa agua viva? ¿Eres tú más grande que nuestro antepasado Jacob, que nos dio el pozo y bebió de él con sus hijos y sus rebaños?». Jesús le dijo: «Todo el que beba de esta agua volverá a tener sed, pero el que beba del agua que yo le daré nunca volverá a tener sed. El agua que yo le daré se convertirá en él en una fuente de agua que brota para la vida eterna». – Juan 4: 11-14

No está mal querer sentirse satisfecho; lo que importa es cómo se quiere conseguir. Solo en Dios encontraremos la plenitud definitiva. Pídele ayuda y Él te dará la gracia para luchar por la santidad y convertirte en el santo que Dios quiere que seas.

Asistir a misa con regularidad es necesario para alcanzar la satisfacción que anhelamos. En la liturgia, nos encontramos con Dios de una manera profunda y recibimos instrucciones sobre cómo debemos vivir nuestras vidas para la gloria de Dios. Esto incluye llevar a otros a experimentar esta misma satisfacción, que es el resultado natural de nuestra búsqueda de la santidad (cf. 1 Juan 1:4). Por lo tanto, ¡invita a tus amigos y familiares a misa! Aunque hayan dejado de practicar, tú puedes ser un medio para ponerlos en contacto con la experiencia de la verdad, la belleza y la bondad de Dios.

Drodzy Bracia i Siostry w Chrystusie,

Znalazłem ten artykuł w moich plikach i pomyślałem, że warto się nim podzielić. To ostatnia część artykułu.

Nudzę się

Po trzecie, nudni ludzie powodują jeszcze większą nudę. Kiedy już się pojawi, jej złagodzenie zazwyczaj przejawia się w nałogu, który najczęściej dotyka daną osobę. Dla coraz większej liczby osób narkotykiem z wyboru jest konsumpcja pornografii.

Nie bądź nudną osobą. Utrzymywanie wszystkiego w stanie neutralnym, aby nie urazić innych, lub dążenie do bycia „miłym facetem lub miłą dziewczyną” nie czyni z nas dobrych uczniów Chrystusa. Bóg wzywa nas do świętości, a to często oznacza wprowadzanie zmian! Dlatego musimy podjąć kroki, aby dążyć do świętości, co jest pierwszą zmianą w sposobie myślenia, która musi nastąpić.

Podejmij więc decyzję, aby nie być nudnym: zrób coś cnotliwego i świętego, aby odzwierciedlić tę zmianę w mentalności. Idźcie wielbić Pana podczas Boskiej Liturgii lub Mszy Świętej; jeśli nie jest to możliwe, idźcie wielbić Go podczas adoracji eucharystycznej. Zaangażujcie się w działalność grupy parafialnej (poproście sekretarza parafii o pomoc w nawiązaniu kontaktu), służcie w lokalnym banku żywności lub spiżarni lub zbierzcie grupę do studiowania Biblii.

Nie mogę uzyskać satysfakcji

Satysfakcja z oglądania pornografii jest ulotna i poniżająca dla wszystkich zaangażowanych stron. Szukając prawdziwej satysfakcji, możemy zwrócić się ku jasnemu odkupieniu zawartemu w słowach Jezusa w ewangelicznej opowieści o „kobiecie przy studni”:

Kobieta rzekła do Niego: „Panie, nie masz czerpaka, a studnia jest głęboka. Skąd weźmiesz tę wodę żywą? Czy jesteś większy od naszego przodka Jakuba, który dał nam tę studnię i wraz ze swoimi synami i stadami pił z niej?”. Jezus odpowiedział jej: „Każdy, kto pije tę wodę, znów będzie pragnął, ale kto pije wodę, którą Ja mu dam, nigdy nie będzie pragnął. Woda, którą Ja mu dam, stanie się w nim źródłem wody tryskającej ku życiu wiecznemu”.

– Ewangelia według św. Jana 4: 11-14

Nie ma nic złego w pragnieniu zadowolenia; liczy się tylko to, w jaki sposób chcesz to osiągnąć. Tylko w Bogu znajdziemy ostateczne spełnienie. Poproś Go o pomoc, a On da ci łaskę, abys dążył do świętości i stał się świętym, jakim Bóg chce, abys był.

Regularne uczestnictwo we Mszy św. jest niezbędne do osiągnięcia satysfakcji, której pragniemy. W liturgii spotykamy Boga w głęboki sposób i otrzymujemy wskazówki, jak mamy żyć dla chwały Bożej. Obejmuje to doprowadzanie innych do doświadczenia tej samej satysfakcji, co jest naturalnym skutkiem naszego dążenia do świętości (por. 1 J 1, 4). Zapraszaj więc swoich przyjaciół i rodzinę na Mszę! Nawet jeśli odeszli od praktyki religijnej, możesz być dla nich środkiem, który pozwoli im doświadczyć Bożej prawdy, piękna i dobroci.
