

Easter 2026

Dear Friends in Christ,

Before the proclamation of the gospel at the Easter Vigil liturgy, there is a deeply powerful and moving moment. It is the joyous triple Alleluia. It not only signals the end of our penitential observances but it expresses our passage with the Lord through his passion, death, and burial. Alleluia is our joyful shout of triumph for as Christ rises from the dead, so do we.

Yet, we may find that our Easter joy has been dampened this year in the face of the daunting challenges of war, the upheavals experienced by migrant families, the great turbulence and polarization in our political life, and the myriad uncertainties about our future and the future of our children. Can we sing Alleluia and mean it?

Experiencing those sentiments myself I am drawn to Saint Paul's words to the Thessalonians. In a moment of suffering loss, confusion and grief he wrote: "But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers and sisters, about those who have died, so that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope. For since we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so, through Jesus, God will bring with him those who have died." (1Thessalonians 4:13-14)

Listen carefully to Paul's words. He tells the Thessalonians that they can grieve and that they can experience struggle and loss. But they must not grieve or suffer as those who have no hope, as those who do not believe that Jesus died and rose and will take us to himself. Like the Thessalonians, we do not ignore or deny the suffering and grief we are experiencing, but we are not held captive to this moment nor to this world. We hold fast to Christ our hope who draws us into a future defined and shaped by his Resurrection.

So, sisters and brothers, let's not hold back our shouts of joy. Let us sing with gusto our Alleluia for it bears witness to our enduring hope in Christ's Resurrection. It inspires us to do what we can to allow his risen life to take hold of and shape our lives and to empower us to reach out to our wounded world. A blessed Easter to all of you and your loved ones.

Drodzy Przyjaciele w Chrystusie,

Przed odczytaniem Ewangelii podczas liturgii Wigilii Paschalnej następuje niezwykle poruszający i głęboko wymowny moment. Jest nim radosne trzykrotne „Alleluja”. Nie tylko oznacza ono koniec naszych praktyk pokutnych, ale także wyraża nasze przejście wraz z Panem przez Jego mękę, śmierć i złożenie do grobu. „Alleluja” jest naszym radosnym okrzykiem zwycięstwa, bo jak Chrystus powstaje z martwych, tak i my powstajemy.

Możemy jednak odczuwać, że nasza wielkanocna radość została w tym roku przytłumiona ogromnymi wyzwaniami: wojnami, wstrząsami, jakich doświadczają rodziny imigrantów, wielkimi napięciami i podziałami w życiu politycznym oraz niepewnościami dotyczącymi naszej przyszłości i przyszłości naszych dzieci. Czy w obliczu tego wszystkiego potrafimy radośnie śpiewać „Alleluja”?

Kiedy sam doświadczam tych uczuć, wracam do słów św. Pawła skierowanym do Tesaloniczan. W chwili cierpienia, straty, braku jasności i żalu Apostoł napisał: „Nie chcemy, bracia, waszego trwania w niewiedzy co do tych, którzy umierają, abyście się nie smucili jak wszyscy ci, którzy nie mają nadziei. Jeśli bowiem wierzymy, że Jezus istotnie umarł i zmartwychwstał, to również tych, którzy umarli w Jezusie, Bóg wyprowadzi wraz z Nim”. (1 Tes 4,13–14)

Wysłuchajmy się uważnie w słowa św. Pawła. Mówi on Tesaloniczanom, że mogą się smucić i doświadczać trudności oraz straty. Nie mogą jednak smucić się ani cierpieć jak ci, którzy nie mają nadziei — jak ci, którzy nie wierzą, że Jezus umarł i zmartwychwstał oraz, że przyjmie nas do siebie. Podobnie jak Tesaloniczanie, nie ignorujemy cierpienia i żalu ani nie zaprzeczamy naszym doświadczeniom, jednak pamiętajmy, że nie jesteśmy więźniami tej chwili ani tego świata. Trwajmy mocno przy Chrystusie, naszej nadziei, który prowadzi nas ku przyszłości określonej i ukształtowanej przez swoje Zmartwychwstanie.

Dlatego, Siostry i Bracia, nie powstrzymujmy naszych okrzyków radości. Śpiewajmy z całego serca „Alleluja”, ponieważ jest ono świadectwem naszej trwałej nadziei w Zmartwychwstaniu Chrystusa. Niech inspiruje nas do czynienia wszystkiego, co w naszej mocy, aby Jego zmartwychwstałe życie przenikało i kształtowało nasze życie oraz uzdalniało nas do wyjścia naprzeciw zranionemu światu. Błogosławionych Święt Wielkanocnych dla Was i Waszych bliskich.

Face the world as you face a tumultuous and tempestuous sea. Sail across this world in the boat of your interior peacefulness, without losing sight of the harbor.

When the strong winds of its desires try to take hold of you, call for help and awake Christ sleeping in the cabin of your heart.

THE UPRIGHT OF HEART


