## FROM THE PASTORS DESK DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO OD PROBOSZA BIURKA

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On May 9 we will be celebrating the Sacrament of First Holy Communion. We congratulate the families of those who have received their First Holy Communion. The following is a brief explanation of First Holy Communion.

### *The Catholic Sacrament of Holy Communion*

Of all seven sacraments, the Holy Eucharist, or Holy Communion, is the most central and important to Catholicism. Holy Communion is offered at every Mass, and in fact, the ritual of the Mass is largely taken up with preparing the hosts (wafers made of wheat and water, or gluten-free) and wine to become the body and blood of Christ and the congregation to receive the body of Christ. Transubstantiation is the act of changing the substances of bread and wine into the substances of the Body and Blood of Christ.

The Holy Eucharist refers to Christ's body and blood present in the consecrated host on the altar, and Catholics believe that the consecrated bread and wine are actually the body and blood, soul and divinity of Christ. For Catholics, the presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist isn't just symbolic, it's real.

When you receive Holy Communion, you're intimately united with Jesus Christ — he literally becomes part of you. Also, by taking Holy Communion, you express your union with all Catholics who believe the same doctrines, obey the same laws, and follow the same leaders. This sense of participation in a larger community is why Catholics (and Eastern Orthodox Christians) have a strict law that only people who are in communion with the Church can receive Holy Communion. In other words, only those who are united in the same beliefs are allowed to receive Holy Communion

### *Dressing up for your First Holy Communion*

When boys and girls make their First Holy Communion (usually in second grade), it's a big occasion for Catholic families. Like their Baptism or Confirmation, the day of First Communion is one filled with family, friends, and feasting after the sacred event has taken place in church.

Girls typically wear white gowns and veils and often look like little brides, and boys wear their Sunday best or new suits and ties bought for the occasion.

The children are generally too young to appreciate all the theological refinements, but as long as they know and believe that it's not bread or wine they're receiving but the real Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, then they are old enough to take Holy Communion.

Estimados Hermanos/as en Cristo,

El 9 de mayo celebraremos el sacramento de la Primera Comunión. Felicitamos a las familias de los que han recibido su Primera Comunión. A continuación, ofrecemos una breve explicación sobre la Primera Comunión.

### *El sacramento católico de la santa comunión*

De los siete sacramentos, la Sagrada Eucaristía o la Sagrada Comunión es el más central e importante para el catolicismo.

La Sagrada Comunión se ofrece en cada Misa y, de hecho, el ritual de la Misa se retoma en gran medida con la preparación de las hostias (obleas hechas de trigo y agua, o sin gluten) y el vino para que se conviertan en el cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo y la congregación para recibir el cuerpo de Cristo. La transubstanciación es el acto de transformar las sustancias del pan y el vino en las sustancias del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo.

La Sagrada Eucaristía se refiere al cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo presentes en la hostia consagrada en el altar, y los católicos creen que el pan y el vino consagrados son en realidad el cuerpo y la sangre, el alma y la divinidad de Cristo.

Para los católicos, la presencia de Cristo en la Sagrada Eucaristía no es solo simbólica, es real.

Cuando recibes la Sagrada Comunión, estás íntimamente unido a Jesucristo, él literalmente se convierte en parte de ti.

Además, al tomar la Sagrada Comunión, expresas tu unión con todos los católicos que creen las mismas doctrinas, obedecen las mismas leyes y siguen los mismos líderes. Este sentido de participación en una comunidad más grande es la razón por la que los católicos (y los cristianos ortodoxos orientales) tienen una ley estricta de que solo las personas que están en comunión con la Iglesia pueden recibir la Sagrada Comunión. En otras palabras, solo aquellos que están unidos en las mismas creencias pueden recibir la Sagrada Comunión.

### *Vestirse para su Primera Comunión*

Cuando los niños y las niñas hacen su Primera Comunión (generalmente en segundo grado), es una gran ocasión para las familias católicas. Al igual que su Bautismo o Confirmación, el día de la Primera Comunión está lleno de familiares, amigos y festejos después de que el evento sagrado haya tenido lugar en la iglesia.

Las niñas suelen llevar vestidos y velos blancos y, a menudo, parecen novias pequeñas, y los niños visten sus mejores galas de domingo o trajes y corbatas nuevos comprados para la ocasión.

Los niños son generalmente demasiado pequeños para apreciar todos los refinamientos teológicos, pero siempre que sepan y crean que no es pan o vino lo que reciben, sino el verdadero Cuerpo y Sangre de Jesucristo, entonces tienen la edad suficiente para tomar la Sagrada Comunión.

Drodzy Bracia i Siostry w Chrystusie,

9 maja będziemy obchodzić sakrament Pierwszej Komunii Świętej. Gratulujemy rodzinom tych, którzy przyjęli Pierwszą Komunię Świętą. Poniżej znajduje się krótkie wyjaśnienie dotyczące Pierwszej Komunii Świętej.

### ***Katolicki Sakrament Komunii Świętej***

Ze wszystkich siedmiu sakramentów Najświętsza Eucharystia, czyli Komunia Święta, jest najważniejszym i najważniejszym dla katolicyzmu miejscem. Komunia Święta jest oferowana podczas każdej Mszy św. I faktycznie rytuał Mszy jest w dużej mierze związany z przygotowaniem hostii (opłatków z pszenicy i wody lub bezglutenowych) i wina, aby stały się Ciałem i Krwią Chrystusa i Chrystusa. zboru, aby przyjąć ciało Chrystusa. Przeistoczenie jest aktem przemiany substancji chleba i wina w substancje Ciała i Krwi Chrystusa.

Święta Eucharystia odnosi się do Ciała i Krwi Chrystusa obecnych w konsekrowanej hostii na ołtarzu, a katolicy wierzą, że konsekrowany chleb i wino to w rzeczywistości Ciało i Krew, Dusza i Bóstwo Chrystusa. Dla katolików obecność Chrystusa w Najświętszej Eucharystii jest nie tylko symboliczna, jest rzeczywista.

Kiedy przyjmujesz Komunię Świętą, jesteś głęboko zjednoczony z Jezusem Chrystusem - On dosłownie staje się częścią Ciebie. Przyjmując Komunię Świętą, wyrażasz także swój związek ze wszystkimi katolikami, którzy wierzą w te same doktryny, przestrzegają tych samych praw i podążają za tymi samymi przywódcami. To poczucie uczestnictwa w większej wspólnocie jest powodem, dla którego katolicy (i prawosławni) mają surowe prawo, że tylko osoby pozostające w komunii z Kościołem mogą przystępować do Komunii Świętej. Innymi słowy, tylko ci, którzy są zjednoczeni w tych samych przekonaniach, mogą przyjąć Komunię Świętą

### ***Przebranie się do Pierwszej Komunii Świętej***

Kiedy chłopcy i dziewczęta przystępują do Pierwszej Komunii Świętej (zwykle w drugiej klasie), jest to wielka okazja dla rodzin katolickich. Podobnie jak ich chrzest lub bierzmowanie, dzień Pierwszej Komunii jest wypełniony rodziną, przyjaciółmi i uczniami po tym, jak święte wydarzenie miało miejsce w kościele.

Dziewczęta zazwyczaj noszą białe suknie i welony i często wyglądają jak małe panny młode, a chłopcy noszą swoje niedzielne stroje lub nowe garnitury i krawaty kupione na tę okazję.

Dzieci są na ogół zbyt małe, aby docenić wszystkie teologiczne udoskonalenia, ale jeśli wiedzą i wierzą, że nie otrzymują chleba ani wina, ale prawdziwe Ciało i Krew Jezusa Chrystusa, wtedy są na tyle duże, aby przyjmować Komunię Świętą.
