FROM THE PASTORS DESK DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO OD PROBOSZA BIURKA

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On May 15, we celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation of our Religious Education Program. It was a beautiful ceremony. We all should remember what this Sacrament means in our lives and in the life of the Church.

The Catholic Sacrament of Confirmation

Just as bodies and minds grow, Catholics believe that the soul also needs to grow in the life of grace. The sacrament of Confirmation builds on the sacraments of Baptism, Penance, and Holy Communion, completing the process of initiation into the Catholic community. (Note: The Byzantine Church confirms (or chrismates) at Baptism and gives Holy Eucharist as well, thus initiating the new Christian all at the same time.)

What the Catholic sacrament of Confirmation means:

Confirmation, a sacrament of initiation, establishes young adults as full-fledged members of the faith. This sacrament is called Confirmation because the faith given in Baptism is now confirmed and made strong. During your Baptism, your parents and godparents make promises to renounce Satan and believe in God and the Church on your behalf. At Confirmation, you renew those same promises, this time speaking for yourself.

During Confirmation, the focus is on the Holy Spirit, who confirmed the apostles on Pentecost and gave them courage to practice their faith. Catholics believe that the same Holy Spirit confirms Catholics during the Sacrament of Confirmation and gives them the same gifts.

Traditionally, the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude (courage), knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. These gifts are supernatural graces given to the soul. The 12 fruits of the Holy Spirit are charity, joy, peace, patience, benignity, goodness, long-suffering, mildness, faith, modesty, continency, and chastity — human qualities that can be activated by the Holy Spirit.

Being confirmed in the Church means accepting responsibility for your faith and destiny. Adulthood, even young adulthood, means that you must do what's right on your own, not for the recognition or reward but merely because it's the right thing to do.

Estimados Hermanos/as en Cristo,

El 15 de mayo celebramos el Sacramento de la Confirmación de nuestro Programa de Educación Religiosa. Fue una hermosa ceremonia. Todos debemos recordar lo que este Sacramento significa en nuestras vidas y en la vida de la Iglesia.

El Sacramento Católico de la Confirmación

Así como los cuerpos y las mentes crecen, los católicos creen que el alma también necesita crecer en la vida de la gracia. El sacramento de la Confirmación se basa en los sacramentos del Bautismo, la Penitencia y la Sagrada Comunión, completando el proceso de iniciación en la comunidad católica.

(Nota: La Iglesia bizantina confirma (o comparecencia) en el Bautismo y también da la Sagrada Eucaristía, iniciando al nuevo cristiano al mismo tiempo).

Lo que significa el sacramento católico de la Confirmación:

La Confirmación, un sacramento de iniciación, establece a los jóvenes adultos como miembros plenos de la fe. Este sacramento se llama Confirmación porque la fe dada en el Bautismo ahora se confirma y se fortalece. Durante su Bautismo, sus padres y padrinos hacen promesas de renunciar a Satanás y creer en Dios y la Iglesia en su nombre. En la Confirmación, renuevas esas mismas promesas, esta vez hablando por ti mismo.

Durante la Confirmación, el foco está en el Espíritu Santo, quien confirmó a los apóstoles el día de Pentecostés y les dio coraje para practicar su fe. Los católicos creen que el mismo Espíritu Santo confirma a los católicos durante el Sacramento de la Confirmación y les da los mismos dones.

Tradicionalmente, los siete dones del Espíritu Santo son sabiduría, entendimiento, consejo, fortaleza (coraje), conocimiento, piedad y temor al Señor. Estos regalos son gracias sobrenaturales dadas al alma. Los 12 frutos del Espíritu Santo son caridad, alegría, paz, paciencia, benignidad, bondad, longanimidad, benignidad, fe, modestia, continencia y castidad, cualidades humanas que pueden ser activadas por el Espíritu Santo.

Ser confirmado en la Iglesia significa aceptar la responsabilidad de tu fe y tu destino. La edad adulta, incluso la edad adulta joven, significa que debes hacer lo correcto por ti mismo, no por el reconocimiento o la recompensa, sino simplemente porque es lo correcto.

Drodzy Bracia i Siostry w Chrystusie,

W dniu 15 maja obchodziliśmy sakrament bierzmowania naszego Programu Edukacji Religijnej. Była to piękna uroczystość. Wszyscy powinniśmy pamiętać, co ten sakrament oznacza w naszym życiu i w życiu Kościoła.

Katolicki Sakrament Bierzmowania

Podobnie jak ciała i umysły wzrastają, katolicy wierzą, że dusza także musi wzrastać w życiu łaski. Sakrament bierzmowania opiera się na sakramentach chrztu, pokuty i komunii świętej, kończąc proces wtajemniczenia w wspólnotę katolicką. (Uwaga: Kościół bizantyjski potwierdza (lub charyzmatuje) na chrzcie i daje także Świętą Eucharystię, tym samym inicjując nowego chrześcijanina w tym samym czasie).

Co oznacza katolicki sakrament bierzmowania:

Bierzmowanie, sakrament inicjacji, ustanawia młodych dorosłych jako pełnoprawnych członków wiary. Ten sakrament nazywa się Bierzmowaniem, ponieważ wiara w Chrztost jest teraz potwierdzona i wzmocniona. Podczas Twojego chrztu twoi rodzice i rodzice chrzestni składają obietnice wyrzeczenia się Szatana i wiary w Boga i Kościół w twoim imieniu. W Potwierdzeniu odnawiasz te same obietnice, tym razem mówiąc dla siebie.

Podczas bierzmowania skupiamy się na Duchu Świętym, który potwierdził apostołów w dniu Pięćdziesiątnicy i dał im odwagę, by praktykować swoją wiarę. Katolicy wierzą, że ten sam Duch Święty potwierdza katolików podczas sakramentu bierzmowania i daje im te same dary.

Tradycyjnie, siedem darów Ducha Świętego to mądrość, zrozumienie, rady, hart ducha, wiedza, pobożność i lęk przed Panem. Te dary są nadprzyrodzonymi łaskami danym duszom. 12 owoców Ducha Świętego to miłość, radość, pokój, cierpliwość, dobroć, dobroć, cierpliwość, łagodność, wiara, skromność, trwanie i czystość - ludzkie cechy, które mogą być aktywowane przez Ducha Świętego.

Potwierdzenie w Kościele oznacza przyjęcie odpowiedzialności za wiarę i przeznaczenie. Dorosłość, nawet młoda dorosłość, oznacza, że musisz robić to, co jest dobre na własną rękę, nie dla uznania czy nagrody, ale tylko dlatego, że jest to słuszne.
