Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

### *The timing and origins of Pentecost (From the Catholic News Agency)*

Pentecost always occurs 50 days after the death and resurrection of Jesus, and ten days after his ascension into heaven. Because Easter is a moveable feast without a fixed date, and Pentecost depends on the timing of Easter, Pentecost can fall anywhere between May 10 and June 13.

The timing of these feasts is also where Catholics get the concept of the Novena - nine days of prayer - because in Acts 1, Mary and the Apostles prayed together "continuously" for nine days after the Ascension leading up to Pentecost. The name of the day itself is derived from the Greek word "pentecoste," meaning 50th.

There is a parallel Jewish holiday, Shavu'ot, which falls 50 days after Passover. Shavu'ot is sometimes called the festival of weeks, referring to the seven weeks since Passover.

Originally a harvest feast, Shavu'ot now commemorates the sealing of the Old Covenant on Mount Sinai, when the Lord revealed the Torah to Moses on Mount Sinai. Every year, the Jewish people renew their acceptance of the gift of the Torah on this feast.

### *What happens at Pentecost?*

In the Christian tradition, Pentecost is the celebration of the person of the Holy Spirit coming upon the Apostles, Mary, and the first followers of Jesus, who were gathered together in the Upper Room.

A "strong, driving" wind filled the room where they were gathered, and tongues of fire came to rest on their heads, allowing them to speak in different languages so that they could understand each other. It was such a strange phenomenon that some people thought the Christians were just drunk - but Peter pointed out that it was only the morning, and said the phenomenon was caused by the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit also gave the apostles the other gifts and fruits necessary to fulfill the great commission - to go out and preach the Gospel to all nations. It fulfills the New Testament promise from Christ (Luke 24:46-49) that the Apostles would be "clothed with power" before they would be sent out to spread the Gospel.

### *Where's that in the bible?*

The main event of Pentecost (the strong driving wind and tongues of fire) takes place in Acts 2:13, though the events immediately following (Peter's homily, the baptism of thousands) continue through verse 41.

### *Happy Birthday, Church*

It was right after Pentecost that Peter, inspired by the Holy Spirit, preached his first homily to Jews and other non-believers, in which he opened the scriptures of the Old Testament, showing how the prophet Joel prophesied events and the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

He also told the people that the Jesus they crucified is the Lord and was raised from the dead, which "cut them to the heart." When they asked what they should do, Peter exhorted them to repent of their sins and to be baptised. According to the account in Acts, about 3,000 people were baptised following Peter's sermon.

For this reason, Pentecost is considered the birthday of the Church - Peter, the first Pope, preaches for the first time and converts thousands of new believers. The apostles and believers, for the first time, were united by a common language, and a common zeal and purpose to go and preach the Gospel.

Estimados Hermanos/as en Cristo,

### *El momento y los orígenes de Pentecostés (De la Agencia Católica de Noticias)*

El Pentecostés siempre ocurre 50 días después de la muerte y resurrección de Jesús, y diez días después de su ascensión al cielo. Debido a que la Pascua es una fiesta móvil sin una fecha fija, y Pentecostés depende del momento de la Pascua, Pentecostés puede caer entre el 10 de mayo y el 13 de junio.

El momento de estas fiestas es también donde los católicos obtienen el concepto de la Novena - nueve días de oración - porque en Hechos 1, María y los Apóstoles oraron juntos "continuamente" durante nueve días después de la Ascensión que conduce a Pentecostés. El nombre del día en sí se deriva de la palabra griega "pentecoste", que significa 50°.

Hay una festividad judía paralela, Shavu`ot, que cae 50 días después de la Pascua. Shavu'ot a veces se llama la fiesta de las semanas, refiriéndose a las siete semanas desde la Pascua.

Originalmente una fiesta de la cosecha, Shavu`ot ahora conmemora el sellamiento del Antiguo Pacto en el Monte Sinaí, cuando el Señor le reveló la Torá a Moisés en el Monte Sinaí. Cada año, el pueblo judío renueva su aceptación del regalo de la Torá en esta fiesta.

### *¿Qué sucede en Pentecostés?*

En la tradición cristiana, Pentecostés es la celebración de la persona del Espíritu Santo que viene sobre los Apóstoles, María y los primeros seguidores de Jesús, que estaban reunidos en el Cenáculo.

Un viento "fuerte y fuerte" llenó la habitación donde estaban reunidos, y lenguas de fuego se posaron sobre sus cabezas, lo que les permitió hablar en diferentes idiomas para que pudieran entenderse entre sí. Fue un fenómeno tan extraño que algunas personas pensaron que los cristianos solo estaban borrachos, pero Pedro señaló que era solo por la mañana y dijo que el fenómeno fue causado por el Espíritu Santo.

El Espíritu Santo también les dio a los apóstoles los otros dones y frutos necesarios para cumplir la gran comisión: salir y predicar el Evangelio a todas las naciones. Cumple la promesa de Cristo en el Nuevo Testamento (Lucas 24: 46-49) de que los Apóstoles serían "revestidos de poder" antes de que fueran enviados a difundir el Evangelio.

### *¿Dónde está eso en la Biblia?*

El evento principal de Pentecostés (el viento fuerte y las lenguas de fuego) tiene lugar en Hechos 2:13, aunque los eventos inmediatamente posteriores (la homilía de Pedro, el bautismo de miles) continúan hasta el versículo 41.

### *Feliz cumpleaños, iglesia*

Fue justo después de Pentecostés que Pedro, inspirado por el Espíritu Santo, predicó su primera homilía a judíos y otros no creyentes, en la que abrió las escrituras del Antiguo Testamento, mostrando cómo el profeta Joel profetizó los eventos y la venida del Santo. Espíritu en Pentecostés.

También le dijo a la gente que el Jesús que crucificaron es el Señor y que fue levantado de entre los muertos, lo que "les hirió el corazón". Cuando les preguntaron qué debían hacer, Pedro los exhortó a que se arrepintieran de sus pecados y se bautizaran. Según el relato de Hechos, unas 3.000 personas se bautizaron después del sermón de Pedro.

Por esta razón, Pentecostés se considera el cumpleaños de la Iglesia: Pedro, el primer Papa, predica por primera vez y convierte a miles de nuevos creyentes. Los apóstoles y los creyentes, por primera vez, estaban unidos por un lenguaje común y un celo y propósito comunes de ir a predicar el Evangelio.

Drodzy Bracia i Siostry w Chrystusie,

### *Czas i pochodzenie Pięćdziesiątnicy (z Katolickiej Agencji Informacyjnej)*

Pięćdziesiątnica zawsze ma miejsce 50 dni po śmierci i zmartwychwstaniu Jezusa oraz dziesięć dni po Jego wniebowstąpieniu. Ponieważ Wielkanoc jest świętem ruchomym bez określonej daty, a Pięćdziesiątnica zależy od czasu Wielkanocy, Pięćdziesiątnica może przypadać w dowolnym miejscu między 10 maja a 13 czerwca.

Czas tych świąt jest również momentem, w którym katolicy pojmują koncepcję nowenny - dziewięć dni modlitwy - ponieważ w Dziejach Apostolskich Maryja i Apostołowie modlili się razem „nieprzerwanie” przez dziewięć dni po Wniebowstąpieniu, poprzedzającym Pięćdziesiątnicę. Sama nazwa dnia pochodzi od greckiego słowa „pentecoste”, oznaczającego pięćdziesiąty.

Równolegle odbywa się żydowskie święto Szawuot, które przypada 50 dni po Pesach. Szawu'ot jest czasami nazywany świętem tygodni, odnosząc się do siedmiu tygodni, które upłynęły od Paschy.

Pierwotnie święto żniw, Shavu'ot obecnie upamiętnia zapieczętowanie Starego Przymierza na Górze Synaj, kiedy Pan objawił Torę Mojżeszowi na Górze Synaj. Co roku w to święto Żydzi ponownie przyjmują dar Tory.

### *Co się dzieje w dniu Pięćdziesiątnicy?*

W tradycji chrześcijańskiej Pięćdziesiątnica jest celebracją osoby Ducha Świętego, która zstąpiła na Apostołów, Maryję i pierwszych naśladowców Jezusa, zgromadzonych w Wieczerniku.

„Silny, porywający” wiatr wypełnił pomieszczenie, w którym byli zebrani, a języki ognia spoczęły na ich głowach, pozwalając im mówić różnymi językami, aby mogli się nawzajem rozumieć. Było to tak dziwne zjawisko, że niektórzy ludzie myśleli, że chrześcijanie są po prostu pijani - ale Piotr zwrócił uwagę, że był to tylko poranek, i powiedział, że to zjawisko zostało spowodowane przez Ducha Świętego.

Duch Święty dał także apostołom inne dary i owoce niezbędne do wypełnienia wielkiego zadania - wyjścia i głoszenia Ewangelii wszystkim narodom. Spełnia obietnicę Nowego Testamentu od Chrystusa (Łk 24: 46-49), że Apostołowie zostaną „przyobleczeni mocą”, zanim zostaną wysłani, by głosić Ewangelię.

### *Gdzie to jest w Biblii?*

Główne wydarzenie Pięćdziesiątnicy (silny wicher i języki ognia) ma miejsce w Dziejach Apostolskich 2:13, chociaż wydarzenia bezpośrednio następujące po nich (homilia Piotra, chrzest tysięcy) są kontynuowane w wersecie 41.

### *Wszystkiego najlepszego, Kościele*

Tuż po Zesłaniu Ducha Świętego Piotr, natchniony Duchem Świętym, wygłosił swoją pierwszą homilię Żydom i innym niewierzącym, w której otworzył pisma Starego Testamentu, pokazując, jak prorok Joel prorokował wydarzenia i przyjście Świętego Ducha w dniu Pięćdziesiątnicy.

Powiedział też ludziom, że Jezus, którego ukrzyżowali, jest Panem i zmartwychwstał, co „przeszyło ich serce”. Kiedy zapytali, co mają zrobić, Piotr zachęcił ich, aby odpokutowali za swoje grzechy i przyjęli chrzest. Według relacji z Dziejów Apostolskich po kazaniu Piotra ochrzczono około 3000 osób.

Z tego powodu dzień Pięćdziesiątnicy uważany jest za dzień narodzin Kościoła - Piotr, pierwszy papież, po raz pierwszy naucza i nawraca tysiące nowych wierzących. Apostołów i wierzących po raz pierwszy zjednoczył wspólny język, wspólna gorliwość i chęć głoszenia Ewangelii.

In John's Gospel, Jesus gently breathes upon the disciples, imparting peace and the Holy Spirit upon them. Paul writes of the spiritual gifts the Holy Spirit brings. The responsorial psalm and sequence invite us to call out for the Holy Spirit, who indeed renews the earth and all of us on the face of it.

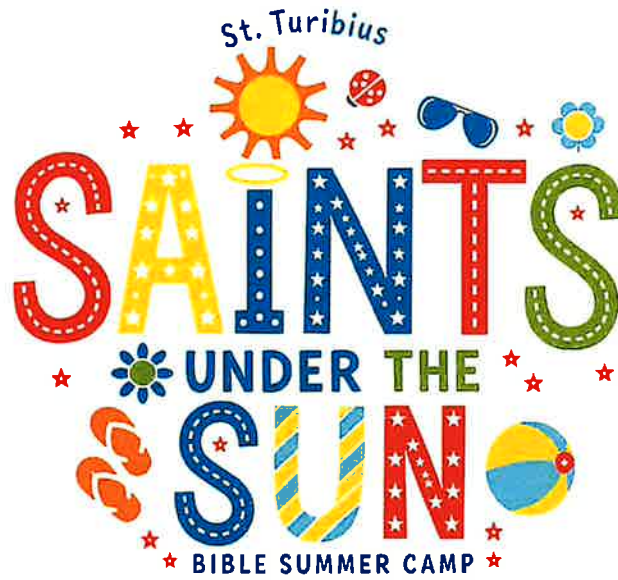
