## FROM THE PASTORS DESK DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO OD PROBOSZCZA BIURKA



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This is the conclusion of the history of the feast of the Body and Blood of Our Lord (Corpus Christi).

So why another feast, so similar to the Last Supper, and why now – after the Ascension and Pentecost? Maybe as a reminder of the last verse of Matthew’s Gospel, where, just before His ascension into heaven, Jesus tells His disciples: “And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.” At the time, it may have seemed contradictory that Jesus was leaving them while also telling them He would be with them – how was this possible? The answer is simple: the Eucharist! Jesus confirmed His actual presence in the Holy Eucharist until the end of time.

In August of 1964, on the 700th anniversary of the institution of the feast of Corpus Christi, Pope Saint Paul VI celebrated Holy Mass at the altar where the holy corporal is kept in its golden shrine in the Cathedral of Orvieto.

In today’s culture though, religion has been pushed aside, watered down, or outright blasted for being useless. Likewise, faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament has waned. According to a 2019 Pew Research Center survey, only 31% of self-described Catholics believe that the bread and wine actually become the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ during the consecration at Mass. Granted, it is a very difficult concept to believe. In the sixth chapter of John’s Gospel, after Jesus explained that one must eat His flesh and drink His blood in order to have eternal life, “... many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him.” This is why the Real Presence is a mystery of our faith. In our finite, human understanding, something that looks, feels, and tastes like bread simply doesn’t look, feel, or taste like the body of a person. This is why we need to pray for an increase of faith: “I do believe, help my unbelief!” (Mark 9:24).

Thankfully, we have abundant opportunities to increase our knowledge of the Eucharist, thereby giving the Holy Spirit additional room to work in our hearts and grow our faith.

\* Read the Gospels and reflect on the words and actions of Jesus.

\* Consider the references to the Eucharist throughout Scripture – how it relates to Passover and the sacrificial lamb; the exodus from Egypt and receiving manna from heaven; and Jesus’ miracles of feeding thousands of people from just a few loaves.

\* Study writings from the saints that encourage us to consider our own experiences and view them with the eyes of faith.

\* Watch videos or studies about the Eucharist on Formed.org – available to all parishioners.

## **FROM THE PASTORS DESK DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO OD PROBOSZA BIURKA**



Estimados Hermanos/as en Cristo,

Así concluye la historia de la fiesta del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Nuestro Señor (Corpus Christi).

¿Por qué otra fiesta, tan parecida a la Última Cena, y por qué ahora, después de la Ascensión y Pentecostés? Tal vez como recordatorio del último versículo del Evangelio de Mateo, donde, justo antes de su ascensión al cielo,

Jesús dice a sus discípulos: «Y he aquí que yo estoy con vosotros todos los días hasta el fin del mundo». En aquel momento, pudo parecer contradictorio que Jesús les dejara y al mismo tiempo les dijera que estaría con ellos, ¿cómo era posible? La respuesta es sencilla: ¡la Eucaristía! Jesús confirmó su presencia real en la Sagrada Eucaristía hasta el final de los tiempos.

En agosto de 1964, en el 700 aniversario de la institución de la fiesta del Corpus Christi, el Papa San Pablo VI celebró la Santa Misa en el altar donde se conserva el santo corporal en su relicario dorado de la catedral de Orvieto.

Sin embargo, en la cultura actual, la religión se ha dejado de lado, se ha diluido o se ha tachado de inútil. Del mismo modo, la fe en la Presencia Real de Jesús en el Santísimo Sacramento ha disminuido. Según una encuesta del Pew Research Center de 2019, solo el 31% de los autodenominados católicos creen que el pan y el vino se convierten realmente en el Cuerpo y la Sangre, el Alma y la Divinidad de Jesucristo durante la consagración en la Misa. Sin duda, es un concepto muy difícil de creer. En el sexto capítulo del Evangelio de Juan, después de que Jesús explicara que hay que comer su carne y beber su sangre para tener vida eterna, «... muchos de sus discípulos volvieron a su antigua forma de vida y ya no le acompañaban.» Por eso la Presencia Real es un misterio de nuestra fe. En nuestra comprensión humana finita, algo que parece, se siente y sabe a pan simplemente no parece, se siente o sabe cómo el cuerpo de una persona. Por eso tenemos que rezar para que aumente nuestra fe: «Creo, ¡ayuda a mi incredulidad!». (Marcos 9:24).

Afortunadamente, tenemos abundantes oportunidades para aumentar nuestro conocimiento de la Eucaristía, dando así al Espíritu Santo espacio adicional para trabajar en nuestros corazones y hacer crecer nuestra fe.

\* Lee los Evangelios y reflexiona sobre las palabras y las acciones de Jesús.

\* Considera las referencias a la Eucaristía a lo largo de la Escritura: cómo se relaciona con la Pascua y el cordero del sacrificio; el éxodo de Egipto y la recepción del maná del cielo; y los milagros de Jesús de alimentar a miles de personas con unos pocos panes.

\* Estudiar escritos de los santos que nos animen a considerar nuestras propias experiencias y verlas con los ojos de la fe.

\* Ver videos o estudios sobre la Eucaristía en Formed.org - disponible para todos los feligreses.

Drodzy Bracia i Siostry w Chrystusie,

Na tym kończy się historia święta Ciała i Krwi Pańskiej (Bożego Ciała).

Dlaczego więc kolejne święto, tak podobne do Ostatniej Wieczerzy, i dlaczego teraz - po Wniebowstąpieniu i Zesłaniu Ducha Świętego? Może jako przypomnienie ostatniego wersetu Ewangelii Mateusza, gdzie tuż przed swoim wniebowstąpieniem do nieba Jezus mówi swoim uczniom: „A oto Ja jestem z wami przez wszystkie dni, aż do skończenia świata”. W tamtym czasie mogło wydawać się sprzeczne, że Jezus ich opuszcza, jednocześnie mówiąc im, że będzie z nimi - jak to było możliwe? Odpowiedź jest prosta: Eucharystia! Jezus potwierdził swoją rzeczywistą obecność w Świętej Eucharystii aż do końca czasów.

W sierpniu 1964 roku, w 700. rocznicę ustanowienia święta Bożego Ciała, papież Paweł VI odprawił mszę świętą przy ołtarzu, na którym przechowywany jest święty korporał w złotym sanktuarium w katedrze w Orvieto.

W dzisiejszej kulturze religia została jednak zepchnięta na bok, rozwodniona lub wręcz zrównana z ziemią jako bezużyteczna. Podobnie osłabła wiara w rzeczywistą obecność Jezusa w Najświętszym Sakramencie. Według ankiety Pew Research Center z 2019 r. tylko 31% katolików uważa, że chleb i wino faktycznie stają się Ciałem i Krwią, Duszą i Boskością Jezusa Chrystusa podczas konsekracji podczas Mszy Świętej. Trzeba przyznać, że jest to bardzo trudna koncepcja do uwierzenia. W szóstym rozdziale Ewangelii Jana, po tym, jak Jezus wyjaśnił, że trzeba jeść Jego ciało i pić Jego krew, aby mieć życie wieczne, „... wielu Jego uczniów powróciło do dawnego sposobu życia i już Mu nie towarzyszyło”. Właśnie dlatego Rzeczywista Obecność jest tajemnicą naszej wiary. W naszym skończonym, ludzkim rozumieniu coś, co wygląda, czuje i smakuje jak chleb, po prostu nie wygląda, nie czuje ani nie smakuje jak ciało osoby. Dlatego musimy modlić się o wzrost wiary: „Wierzę, pomóż niedowiarstwu memu!” (Ew. Marka 9:24).

Na szczęście mamy wiele możliwości, aby poszerzyć naszą wiedzę na temat Eucharystii, dając tym samym Duchowi Świętemu dodatkową przestrzeń do działania w naszych sercach i rozwijania naszej wiary.

\* Przeczytaj Ewangelie i zastanów się nad słowami i czynami Jezusa.

\* Zastanów się nad odniesieniami do Eucharystii w całym Piśmie Świętym - w jaki sposób odnosi się ona do Paschy i baranka ofiarnego; wyjścia z Egiptu i otrzymania manny z nieba; oraz cudów Jezusa polegających na nakarmieniu tysięcy ludzi zaledwie kilkoma bochenkami.

\* Studiuj pisma świętych, które zachęcają nas do rozważenia naszych własnych doświadczeń i spojrzenia na nie oczami wiary.

\* Obejrzyj filmy lub opracowania na temat Eucharystii na stronie Formed.org - dostępnej dla wszystkich parafian.

The Sacred Heart of Jesus is a widely practiced Catholic devotion that honors the physical heart of Jesus Christ as a symbol of His boundless, divine love and mercy for humanity. It emphasizes Christ's compassionate sacrifice and offers believers a spiritual refuge.

#### **History & Origins**

**17th Century:** The modern devotion stems from a series of visions received by St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a French Visitation nun, between 1673 and 1675.

**Visions:** Jesus revealed His heart as burning with love for humanity, asking the Church to publicly honor it and make reparation for the indifference and sins of the world.

**Papal Recognition:** Pope Pius IX officially extended the feast to the universal Church in 1856. Popes Leo XIII, Pius XI, Pius XII, and Pope Francis have all written encyclicals on the devotion.

#### **Core Symbolism**

- **The Heart:** Represents Christ's intense love and humanity.
- **The Crown of Thorns:** Symbolizes the pain caused by the sins of humanity.
- **The Flames:** Signifies the all-consuming, divine fire of His love.
- **The Wound:** Represents the lance strike on the cross, symbolizing that grace and the sacraments continually flow from His heart.

#### **Prayer:**

"O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer You my prayers, works, joys, and sufferings of this day in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world. I offer them for all the intentions of Your Sacred Heart: the salvation of souls, reparation for sins, and the reunion of all Christians. Amen."
