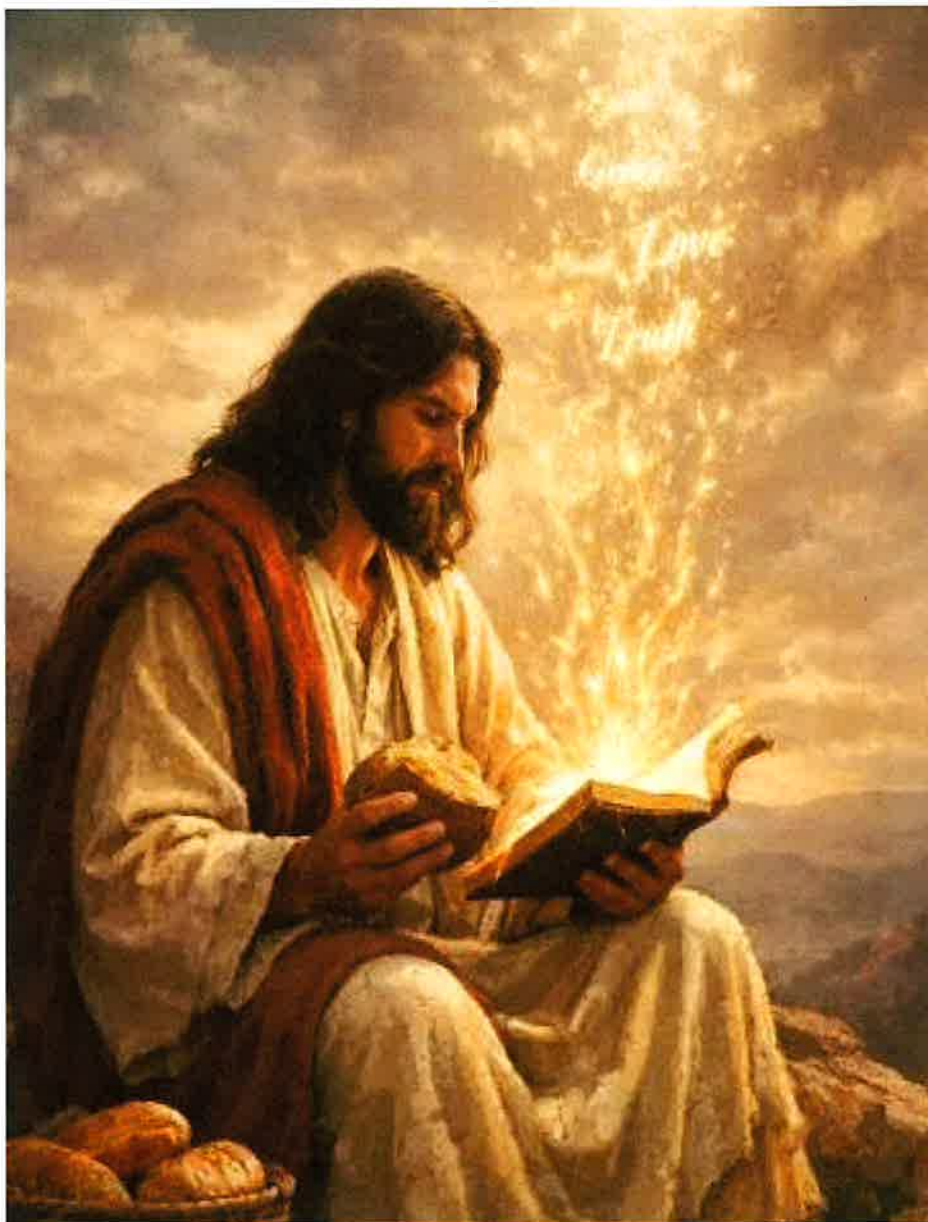

Ochrona godności ludzkiej i opieka nad potrzebującymi

POMÓŻCIE NAM SŁUŻYĆ NAJBIEDNIEJSZYM Z BIEDNYCH

Organizacja „Food for the Poor” powstała w 1982 roku na Jamajce. Obecnie nasza międzywyznaniowa chrześcijańska organizacja służy ubogim głównie w 15 krajach na Karaibach i w Ameryce Łacińskiej. Dzięki naszym wiernym darczyńcom jesteśmy w stanie zapewnić żywność, schronienie, opiekę zdrowotną, edukację, dostęp do czystej wody, pomoc w sytuacjach kryzysowych, rozwiązania w zakresie mikroprzedsiębiorczości i wiele więcej.

Jesteśmy dumni, że nakarmiliśmy miliony ludzi i przekazaliśmy pomoc o wartości ponad 15,7 miliarda dolarów.

Nasza wiara inspiruje nas do bycia organizacją opartą na współczuciu i motywowaną miłością. Naszą misją jest niesienie ulgi najbiedniejszym z biednych w krajach, w których działamy.

Staramy się odzwierciedlać bezwarunkową miłość Boga. Jest to miłość ofiarna, która obejmuje wszystkich ludzi bez względu na rasę czy wyznanie. Wierzimy, że możemy okazywać Jego miłość, służąc „najmniejszym z tych” na tej ziemi, tak jak wezwał nas do tego Chrystus w Ewangelii według św. Mateusza 25. Modlimy się, aby dzięki łasce Bożej i przy Państwa wsparciu mogliśmy nadal nieść ulgę cierpiącym i nadzieję tym, którzy jej stracili.



Ojciec Carlton biegle włada językiem hiszpańskim i pochodzi z licznej rodziny – ma jednego brata i sześć żyjących siostr. Święcenia kapłańskie przyjął 8 czerwca 1974 roku i pełnił posługę proboszcza w pięciu różnych parafiach archidiecezji Indianapolis. Pełnił również funkcję kapelana straży pożarnej w Indianapolis. Ponadto był misjonarzem w Salwadorze i na Haiti. Ojciec Carlton podzieli się osobistym świadectwem na temat misji organizacji „Food For The Poor”, polegającej na opiece nad osobami w skrajnym ubóstwie w krajach rozwijających się, co jest sposobem na urzeczywistnianie ewangelicznej zasady wzajemnej miłości. Proszę o ciepłe powitanie ojca Carltona.
