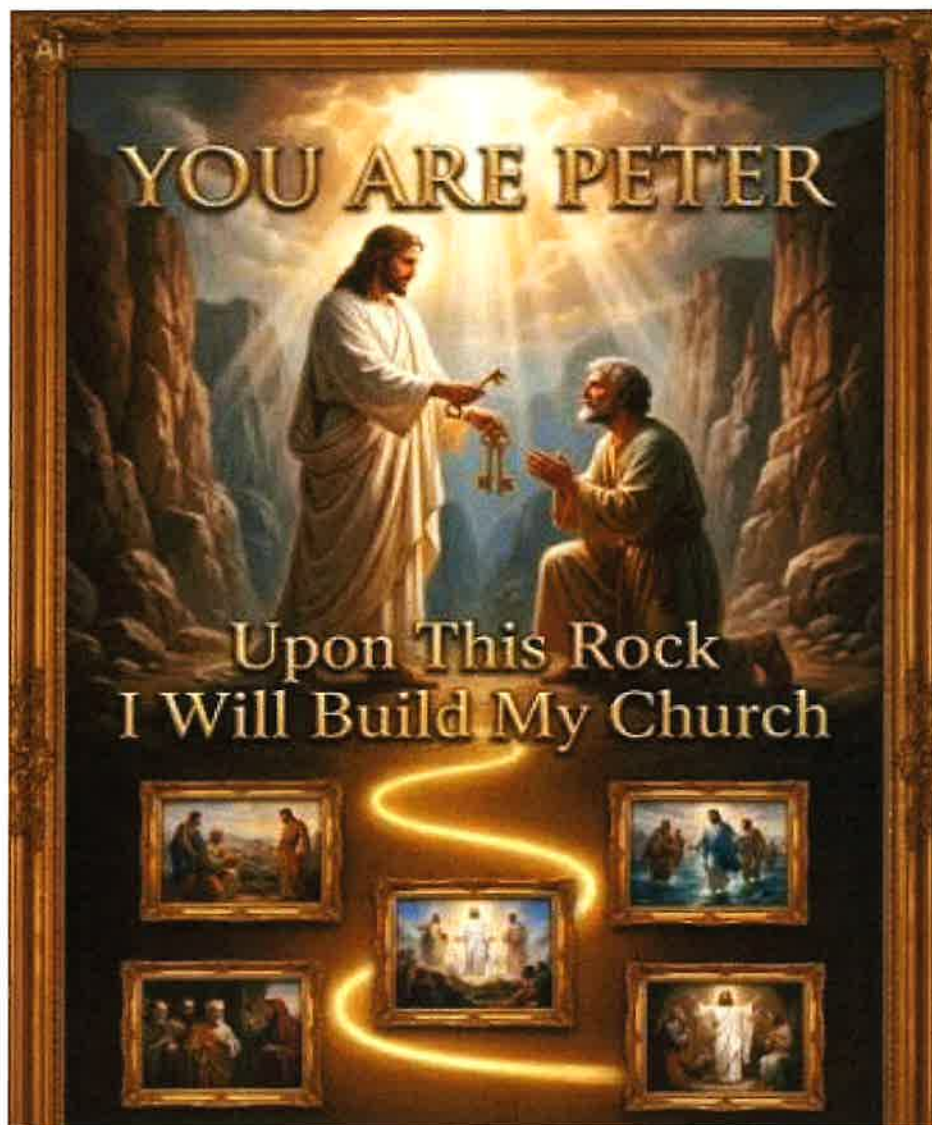

This weekend, we will be hosting Sr. Atoni Bonilla from the Koinonia John the Baptist's Mission. The following is some information.

KOINONIA JOHN THE BAPTIST MISSION

Koinonia John the Baptist's mission is the promotion of New Evangelization through evangelization activities, various training programs and the formation of community.

What distinguishes the Koinonia is its primary announcement of the Gospel, its openness to charismatic signs and its intense community life.

It strives to respond to the needs of the Church by proposing a New Evangelization which is new in its ardor, new in its methods and new in its expression, according to the Magisterium of the Church.

OUR LADY OF LOURDES MISSION

The origins of community's work in Africa dates back to 2002, when the first priests came to Rome from different corners of African continent to participate in the School of New Evangelization.

As a fruit of that experience, we've done some course in South Africa, Zimbabwe, Uganda and Botswana. In September 2004 the consecrated community came to Zimbabwe and started the pastoral work.

They began to live in Bulawayo, where for two months they ran different courses of the School of Evangelization in connection with St. Philip's center.

In 2010, Bishop Stanisław Dziuba invited the community to settle in the Mission dedicated to Our Lady of Lourdes, located in the diocese of Umzimkulu where began pastoral and rebuilding work.

Lourdes Mission is a charming place, surrounded by beautiful hills, settlements and villages.

OUR DIOCESE OF UMZIMKULU IN SOUTH AFRICA

The Diocese of Umzimkulu was established in 1954 by the excision from the Diocese of Mariann hill, of the civil districts of Umzimkulu, Harding and portions of the districts of Port Shepstone, Bulwer and Himeville, south of the Umzimkulu River.

Area: 15 275 sq. km Total Pop: 509 830 Catholic Pop: 82 761.

Diocese of Umzimkulu comprises of 15 parishes that each have from 5 to 14 outstations - chapels to serve by the missionary work.

MISIÓN KOINOIA JUAN EL BAUTISTA

La Misión Koinonia Juan el Bautista tiene como objetivo promover la Nueva Evangelización a través de actividades evangelizadoras, diversos programas de capacitación y la formación de una comunidad.

Lo que distingue a Koinonia es su anuncio prioritario del Evangelio, su apertura a los signos carismáticos y su intensa vida comunitaria.

Se esfuerza por responder a las necesidades de la Iglesia proponiendo una Nueva Evangelización que sea nueva en su ardor, nueva en sus métodos y nueva en su expresión, de acuerdo con el Magisterio de la Iglesia.

MISIÓN DE NUESTRA SEÑORA DE LORDES

Los orígenes del trabajo de la comunidad en África se remontan a 2002, cuando los primeros sacerdotes llegaron a Roma desde diferentes rincones del continente africano para participar en la Escuela de Nueva Evangelización.

Como fruto de esa experiencia, hemos impartido algunos cursos en Sudáfrica, Zimbabue, Uganda y Botsuana. En septiembre de 2004, la comunidad consagrada llegó a Zimbabue y comenzó la labor pastoral.

Comenzaron a vivir en Bulawayo, donde durante dos meses impartieron diversos cursos de la Escuela de Evangelización en colaboración con el centro de San Felipe.

En 2010, el obispo Stanisław Dziuba invitó a la comunidad a establecerse en la Misión dedicada a Nuestra Señora de Lourdes, ubicada en la diócesis de Umzimkulu, donde comenzaron la labor pastoral y de reconstrucción.

La Misión de Lourdes es un lugar encantador, rodeado de bellezas.

NUESTRA DIÓCESIS DE UMZIMKULU EN SUDÁFRICA

La Diócesis de Umzimkulu se estableció en 1954 mediante la separación de la Diócesis de Mariannhill de los distritos civiles de Umzimkulu, Harding y partes de los distritos de Port Shepstone, Bulwer y Himeville, al sur del río Umzimkulu.

Superficie: 15 275 km². Población total: 509 830. Población católica: 82 761.

La Diócesis de Umzimkulu está compuesta por 15 parroquias, cada una de las cuales cuenta con entre 5 y 14 estaciones misionales —capillas destinadas a la labor misionera—.

MISJA KOINOIA ŚW. JANA CHRZCICIELA

Misją Koinonia św. Jana Chrzciciela jest promowanie Nowej Ewangelizacji poprzez działania ewangelizacyjne, różnorodne programy szkoleniowe oraz budowanie wspólnoty.

To, co wyróżnia Koinonię, to przede wszystkim głoszenie Ewangelii, otwartość na znaki charyzmatyczne oraz intensywne życie wspólnotowe.

Misja stara się odpowiadać na potrzeby Kościoła, proponując Nową Ewangelizację, która jest nowa w swoim zapale, nowa w metodach i nowa w sposobie wyrażania się, zgodnie z nauczaniem Kościoła.

MISJA MATKI BOŻEJ Z LORDES

Początki działalności wspólnoty w Afryce sięgają 2002 roku, kiedy to pierwsi księża przybyli do Rzymu z różnych zakątków kontynentu afrykańskiego, aby uczestniczyć w Szkole Nowej Ewangelizacji.

Owocem tego doświadczenia było przeprowadzenie kilku kursów w RPA, Zimbabwe, Ugandzie i Botswanie. We wrześniu 2004 roku wspólnota konsekrowana przybyła do Zimbabwe i rozpoczęła pracę duszpasterską.

Zaczęli mieszkać w Bulawayo, gdzie przez dwa miesiące prowadzili różne kursy w ramach Szkoły Ewangelizacji we współpracy z centrum św. Filipa.

W 2010 roku biskup Stanisław Dziuba zaprosił wspólnotę do osiedlenia się w misji poświęconej Matce Bożej z Lourdes, położonej w diecezji Umzimkulu, gdzie rozpoczęto pracę duszpasterską i odbudowę.

Misja w Lourdes to urocze miejsce, otoczone pięknymi krajobrazami.

NASZA DIECEZJA UMZIMKULU W RPA

Diecezja Umzimkulu została utworzona w 1954 r. w wyniku wydzielenia z diecezji Mariannhill okręgów cywilnych Umzimkulu, Harding oraz części okręgów Port Shepstone, Bulwer i Himeville, położonych na południe od rzeki Umzimkulu.

Powierzchnia: 15 275 km²; Łączna liczba mieszkańców: 509 830; Liczba katolików: 82 761.

Diecezja Umzimkulu składa się z 15 parafii, z których każda posiada od 5 do 14 placówek misyjnych – kaplic służących działalności misyjnej.

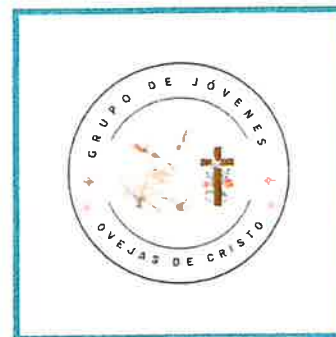
