FROM THE PASTORS DESK DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO OD PROBOSZA BIURKA

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I found this article in my files and thought it would be good to share over the next two weeks.

What are some practical spiritual methods Catholics can use to combat the temptation to consume pornography?

Go To War

First, a key tool in the evil one's toolbox is luring us into a false sense of isolation. Temptation to consume pornography only grows without taking action to rectify loneliness.

Combating this temptation and isolation has a remarkably simple solution: Remember the truth that you are never alone. Jesus is always there to listen, receive you, and meet you where you are in that moment.

Initiating this process can be done by praying the rosary. The Rosary is a tremendous weapon against evil. Every Saint has had a devotion to Our Lady, as She who is the Mother of Jesus is incredibly powerful against the assaults of the infernal foe, due to her humility. Satan has no effective weapon against humility, and it is the weapon of the Rosary that empowers us to humbly go to the most beautiful woman ever, invoke her fair name, and enlist her help in this battle.

"But I've never prayed a Rosary before." That's OK. Pray one Hail Mary, really slowly, focusing on the words. You will find peace and strength where before there was none. Then move to a decade the next week, then the following month, take on praying the whole rosary.

Add in a prayer of protection of St. Michael the Archangel and a deliverance prayer – such as a perimeter prayer – and these will help keep temptations at bay. If you want to change a habit...

Second, utilize a key strategy: if you want to change a habit, change your environment. You must physically change your situation. Call your family, phone a friend, go to Adoration, and, if possible, go to Mass. Physically removing yourself from the situation of isolation can help focus your mind on those around you, and most importantly, on God.

Estimados Hermanos/as en Cristo,

Encontré este artículo en mis archivos y pensé que sería bueno compartirlo durante las próximas dos semanas.

¿Cuáles son algunos métodos espirituales prácticos que los católicos pueden utilizar para combatir la tentación de consumir pornografía?

Ir a la guerra

En primer lugar, una herramienta clave en el arsenal del maligno es atraernos hacia una falsa sensación de aislamiento. La tentación de consumir pornografía solo crece si no se toman medidas para rectificar la soledad.

Combatir esta tentación y el aislamiento tiene una solución muy sencilla: recordar la verdad de que nunca estás solo. Jesús siempre está ahí para escucharte, recibirte y encontrarte donde te encuentres en ese momento.

Este proceso puede iniciarse rezando el rosario. El rosario es un arma formidable contra el mal. Todos los santos han tenido devoción por Nuestra Señora, ya que Ella, como Madre de Jesús, es increíblemente poderosa contra los ataques del enemigo infernal, debido a su humildad. Satanás no tiene ningún arma eficaz contra la humildad, y es el arma del rosario la que nos da el poder de acudir humildemente a la mujer más hermosa que jamás haya existido, invocar su santo nombre y pedirle ayuda en esta batalla.

«Pero nunca antes he rezado un rosario». No pasa nada. Reza un Ave María, muy despacio, concentrándote en las palabras. Encontrarás paz y fuerza donde antes no las había. A la semana siguiente, pasa a una decena. Al mes siguiente, reza el rosario completo.

Añade una oración de protección a San Miguel Arcángel y una oración de liberación, como una oración perimetral, y esto te ayudará a mantener a raya las tentaciones.
Si quieres cambiar un hábito...

En segundo lugar, utiliza una estrategia clave: si quieres cambiar un hábito, cambia tu entorno. Debes cambiar físicamente tu situación. Llama a tu familia, llama a un amigo, ve a la Adoración y, si es posible, ve a misa.

Alejarte físicamente de la situación de aislamiento puede ayudarte a centrar tu mente en los que te rodean y, lo que es más importante, en Dios.

Drodzy Bracia i Siostry w Chrystusie,

Znalazłem ten artykuł w moich plikach i pomyślałem, że warto się nim podzielić w ciągu najbliższych dwóch tygodni.

Jakie praktyczne metody duchowe mogą stosować katolicy, aby zwalczać pokusę konsumpcji pornografii?

Wyrusz na wojnę

Po pierwsze, kluczowym narzędziem w arsenale złego ducha jest zwodnicze poczucie izolacji. Pokusa konsumpcji pornografii tylko się nasila, jeśli nie podejmuje się działań mających na celu zaradzenie samotności.

Walka z tą pokusą i izolacją ma niezwykle proste rozwiązanie: pamiętaj o prawdzie, że nigdy nie jesteś sam. Jezus jest zawsze gotowy, aby cię wysłuchać, przyjąć i spotkać się z tobą tam, gdzie jesteś w danej chwili.

Proces ten można zainicjować poprzez modlitwę różańcową. Różaniec jest potężną bronią przeciwko złu. Każdy święty oddawał cześć Matce Bożej, ponieważ jako Matka Jezusa jest ona niezwykle potężna w walce z atakami piekielnego wroga dzięki swojej pokorze. Szatan nie ma skutecznej broni przeciwko pokorze, a to właśnie broń różańca daje nam siłę, by pokornie zwrócić się do najpiękniejszej kobiety, jaka kiedykolwiek żyła, wzywać jej święte imię i prosić ją o pomoc w tej walce.

„Ale ja nigdy wcześniej nie modliłem się na różańcu”. Nie ma sprawy. Odmów jedną modlitwę „Zdrowaś Maryjo”, bardzo powoli, skupiając się na słowach. Znajdziesz spokój i siłę tam, gdzie wcześniej ich nie było. Następnie w kolejnym tygodniu przejdź do dziesiątki. W następnym miesiącu zacznij modlić się cały różaniec.

Dodaj modlitwę o ochronę św. Michała Archaniola i modlitwę o wybawienie – na przykład modlitwę obronną – które pomogą ci powstrzymać pokusy. Jeśli chcesz zmienić nawyk...

Po drugie, wykorzystaj kluczową strategię: jeśli chcesz zmienić nawyk, zmień swoje otoczenie.

Musisz fizycznie zmienić swoją sytuację. Zadzwoń do rodziny, zadzwoń do przyjaciela, idź na adorację i, jeśli to możliwe, idź na mszę. Fizyczne wyrwanie się z sytuacji izolacji może pomóc skupić umysł na otaczających cię ludziach, a co najważniejsze, na Bogu.
