

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The following is the Holy Week Schedule for 2026.

On Holy Thursday, we will celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Last Supper at 7:00 p.m. This Liturgy will include the presentation of the Holy Oils and the washing of feet. We are looking for volunteers to have their feet washed during the Holy Thursday Liturgy.

The church will remain open until 10:00 p.m. for adoration.


On Good Friday, we will have various services. At 11:00 a.m. there will be an opportunity to follow the Stations of the Cross outdoors. We will begin in front of the Church. Of course, this is if weather permitting. At 3:00 p.m. there will be the Good Friday Service conducted in English, at 5:00 p.m. there will be a Good Friday Service conducted in Spanish and at 7:00 p.m. there will be a Good Friday Service conducted in Polish. The Church will be open until 10:00 p.m. for prayer.

Holy Saturday, there will be the traditional blessing of Easter Baskets. The first blessing will be at 12:00 noon and be conducted in English and Spanish. The second blessing will be at 1:00 p.m. and be conducted in Polish.

The Holy Saturday Easter Vigil Liturgy will begin at 7:00 p.m. During this liturgy 11 people will be confirmed. There are two people who will be baptized, receive Holy Communion and be confirmed and one Profession of Faith.

Did you know that the Easter Triduum is actually one Religious Ceremony? We begin with the Mass of the Lord's Last Supper on Holy Thursday, our service ends with the final blessing at the Easter Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday.

I encourage us all to fully participate in all of the Easter Triduum Services.

El Sábado Santo, tendrá lugar la tradicional bendición de las Cestas de Pascua. La primera bendición será a las 12:00 horas y se realizará en inglés y español. La segunda bendición será a la 1:00 p.m. y se llevará a cabo en polaco.

La Liturgia de la Vigilia Pascual del Sábado Santo comenzará a las 7:00 p.m. Durante esta liturgia, 11 personas recibirán la Confirmación. Hay dos personas que serán bautizadas, recibirán la Sagrada Comunión y serán confirmadas, y una persona realizará su Profesión de Fe.

¿Sabía usted que el Triduo Pascual es en realidad una sola ceremonia religiosa? Comenzamos con la Misa de la Última Cena del Señor el Jueves Santo y se termina con la bendición final de la Misa de la Vigilia de Pascua en el sábado de Gloria.




