W ciągu najbliższych dwóch tygodni poniższe „prawa” będą interesujące, dostarczą nieco humoru i być może skłonią do refleksji.

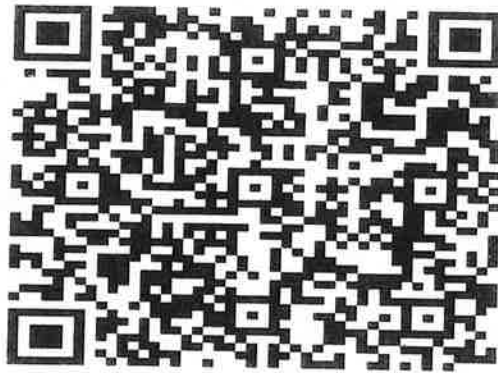

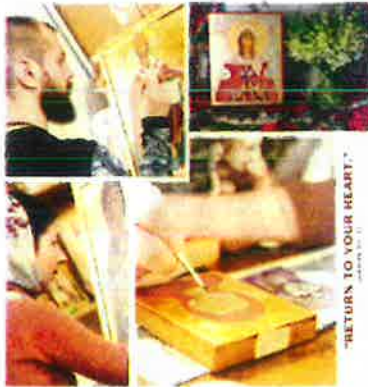
