Short Term Mission Opportunity  
Prague, Czech Republic June 27-July 8, 2024

The Grace missions team is announcing a short-term mission opportunity. On June 27-July 8, 2024, Kontaktmission USA is sponsoring a mission trip to Prague, Czech Republic to work with Russian-speaking teenagers and their families. Many of these families will be refugees from Ukraine. Ukrainians are very interested in their children learning English for their success in the future. Teens are also interested in sports and meeting new people. This connection point allows Americans, who love Jesus, a unique opportunity to build relationships, share the Gospel, and take part in discipling these young people and their parents. Even if you have never taught English as a second language, the materials provided will guide you to be an effective teacher.

This mission project is being led by veteran missionary to Ukraine, Jon Gainer (he and his wife visited us in the fall). If you have questions about this experience, you may find it helpful to contact Jon or Kristina Marburger. Those joining this team will need to raise support estimated to be approximately \$3,250.00. This opportunity just came available and is limited to 4 people from Grace PCA.
