<u>Banquet, March 2</u> – Receive the Financial Faith Commitment Form.

<u>Friday, March 2-Wednesday, March 7</u> – fill out your Financial Faith Commitment Form – keep the pink copy for yourself and put the white and yellow copy in the envelope provided with the form.

<u>Sunday, March 4-Wednesday, March 7</u> – a Messenger will contact you to pick up your form (white & yellow copies) in a sealed envelope provided with the form. You will keep the pink copy.

<u>Thursday, March 8-Saturday, March 10</u> – the Financial Firm and Faith commitments will be tabulated by an outside source and they will mail back to you the yellow copy.

<u>Sunday, March 11</u> – Results of our Financial Faith Commitment will be announced.

(Again, the Financial Firm and Faith Commitment is between you and the Lord – the only person to see it will be the outside Tabulator.)

Nomination ballots for the *Minister of Children* position are due to be returned **today**. After prayerfully discerning any names you feel led to offer, return your completed ballot to the box in the foyer. This job description was in your church mailbox several weeks ago.
