**Building Progress Report:** It is amazing what can be accomplished when it doesn't rain every day! The rain water management system has been dug, and they are moving onto the building itself. The building pad has been created, footers are being dug and concrete poured. Scenic Ridge (*our builder*) has been helpful in identifying de-tails that can be tweaked as they build to save money and have our completed addition look as nice as possible. Please continue to pray for the worker's safety, and that this building would be a blessing to the community.

There will be ongoing prayer for the building and renovation project as it continues this summer, with a weekly prayer focus. Please consider praying for this project and how the Lord will call us to utilize this space for His honor and glory. A Scripture that could guide our prayer is

Matthew 5:14-16: “*You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.*” This week the prayer focus for the building project is for safety for the workers, good weather, wisdom for decisions that have to be made as the work is occurring, and against unexpected complications.

Each Sunday morning during the *Worship in Song* there is a prayer group meeting in Room 3. These intercessors are available to pray with you about any personal concerns. Concerns shared with the team are kept in confidence. The prayer team is also available after the service.

There are two opportunities to serve in this way. 1) Join the Sunday morning prayer team that meets every 3-4 weeks during the worship in song time. 2) Join a prayer group that will meet monthly to pray for the building and renovation project.
