Tell It | Read this week's Bible Story in the Bible then share the story in your own words with a friend or family member. Remember to show them something you created this week.

Key Words This Week

Prayer | talking with God to praise Him, ask Him for help, and confess our sins to Him.

Key Actions This Week

Do | Gather the family to have a "pop up" prayer time. Form a circle and allow each family member to pop up and pray a sentence prayer. Challenge them to think of a Scripture that helps us know how to pray. Encourage family members to report back on how God answers their prayers.

On Mission | Create prayer stations for family members to move through and pray as Jesus taught the disciples to pray. Stations could include thanksgiving, confession, daily needs, others' needs, God's will in their life. Begin the prayer session by reading the Lord's prayer together. (Matthew 6:9-13)

Memorize | Take turns saying this month's Scripture Memory from memory together.
