**Tell It** | Read this week's Bible Story in the Bible then share the story in your own words with a friend or family member. Remember to show them something you created this week.

## **Moments**

Capture the truth as you go.

**Key Words This Week God is good** | God is what is best.

**Obedience** | doing what you're told - right away and with a good attitude. We obey when we know, love, and trust the one who has given commands.

#### **Key Actions This Week**

**Play** | Write various words on notecards. Give a notecard to a family member without him seeing the word. He will hold his notecard on his forehead allowing the other family members to see the word. If you have non-readers in your family, pictures can be used instead. The person with the card will ask the other family members questions to try to figure out the word listed. Talk about how difficult it was to guess the word with only using the answer to his questions.

On Mission | Locate a family in your church or neighborhood who have recently had a baby. Volunteer to make a grocery store run, play with older kids, or watch the new baby while the parents complete tasks around the house. Pray with the family, thanking God for the blessing of the new arrival.

**Pray** | Ask God to help you accept His timing and believe He knows what is best for you.

**Memorize** | Take turns saying this month's Scripture Memory from memory together.
