BEFORE CAMP

- Complete all online registration and payments to the church. *See attached for CampWise instructions.* Our church code is **mayfieldroad**. Find all camp information at **tinyurl.com/summercampportal**.
- Make sure you are at ease about your child going to camp. If your child senses that you might be nervous, he or she will be nervous too.
- Visit the camp's website with your child. Seeing pictures of the campus, the staff and activities that they will be participating in is a great way for your child to be familiar with the camp before they even get there.

- Talk about camp! Ask your child about his or her expectations or questions. Discuss what it might feel like to become homesick, but encourage your son or daughter to trust God's strength and plan on having a great time. Be careful not to discuss the option of calling home since Preteen Camp discourages children to call their parents throughout their stay.
- Read together our Memory Verse for the week.
- Get excited with your child! Make going to camp a big deal. Post a large packing list on your child's wall and mark items off the list as you help your child pack. Share fun stories about your own camp experiences.

PACKING

- **LABEL EVERYTHING!**
- **Bible** – We recommend sending a Bible that does not have any sentimental value. They are sometimes lost or damaged at camp.
- **Shoes** - Athletic shoes (closed toe) are required during all recreation times. Shoes must be worn to and from the pool areas.
- **Clothing** - Clothing must be modest. Shorts and t-shirts can be worn to all activities.
 - *Boys* must wear shirts at all times when not at the pool.
- **Swimwear** – Must be modest. If swimwear is considered inappropriate by a lifeguard, they will be asked to wear a t-shirt. Campers and leaders must wear a cover up to and from the pool areas.
 - *For girls:* no bikinis or revealing swimwear, a modest one piece or two piece tankini. Midriffs must be covered.
 - *For boys:* no cut-offs or revealing swimwear.
- **Bedding** - Bedding for a twin-sized bed, pillow, blanket, or sleeping bag.
- **Personal Items** - One shower towel, one pool towel, shampoo, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, and deodorant.
- **Durable Water Bottle**

What NOT to Bring to Camp

- **Electronics:** Including but not limited to: cell phones, MP3 players, TV's, Video Games, tablets, etc.
- **Weapons:** guns, knives, etc.
- **Miscellaneous:** no fireworks, shaving cream, skate boards, scooters, etc.

MEDICINES

- **Please ensure** you include camper's allergies, food allergies, and other important medication information in online registration.
- All medications **must** be in a quart-sized Ziploc bag with the camper's name and Mayfield Road Baptist Church marked on the bag.
- Medications **must** be in original container.
- Please **do not** pack medicines in camper's luggage. All meds should be handed to Michelle Dozier on Saturday morning upon arrival at MRBC for camp departure.

CAMP HEALTH INFO

Campers should stay home if they are currently experiencing, or have experienced 2 days before arriving at camp, any stomach virus symptom such as vomiting or diarrhea. Also, a child should be fever-free (without medication) for a minimum of 24 hours before coming to camp.

MONEY

Various items from camp personalities are available for purchase. Campers will also have access to purchase crafts, and various snacks and drinks from The Canteen. Small bills are best. **Please note: campers are fully responsible for the money they bring to camp.**

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Parents/Guardians and adult volunteers, the first screen is where you will set up your username and password.
Note: Your username will be your email address.
2. Once you have entered and confirmed the information, click NEXT and you will be taken step by step through the registration process.
3. When you get to the "Enter Your Church Code" page, enter the **Church Code** that is listed at the top of this page. This code is specifically for your church's participants.
4. If you are registering more than one person, complete the registration process for the first person. When you are finished, it will give you the option to return to the home page or register an additional person. Click "add additional attendee" to go through the process to register an additional person.
5. Please be sure to complete all required online forms and medical screen to be completely registered for camp.
