Regathering FAQ

- **Why is registration required for Worship Care (Preschool) on Sundays?**
  - In an effort to provide the safest environment possible, all class sizes have been reduced in capacity. In light of this, we want to make sure you know that you have a space or can plan accordingly if the space is taken up.
- **When is registration available?**
  - Registration is available weekly on Monday through Friday at Noon for the following Sunday at [www.mayfieldroad.org](http://www.mayfieldroad.org). There is limited capacity, so the sooner you register the better. Walk-up registrations will not be permitted during this phase of regathering.
- **What if I need to cancel my reservation?**
  - Please email Phillip Vincent at [phillip@mayfieldroad.org](mailto:phillip@mayfieldroad.org) with your name, your child's name and service you are cancelling for.
- **Why do you ask health screening questions?**
  - Out of an abundance of caution, we want to make sure that children are healthy and not at risk to expose other children or leaders to any form of illness.
- **What are the church's sanitation protocols?**
  - Prior to arrival and after room use, all rooms, toys, and surfaces are disinfected using a multi-step disinfectant process approved by the CDC and EPA.
- **What precautions are in place?**
  - In addition to the sanitation protocols addressed above, all adult leaders will be wearing masks/face coverings. **We ask all adults entering the Preschool Suite to wear a mask as well.** Kids and leaders will hand wash upon entering the classroom and after restroom use. All rooms will be single use only so all items may be sanitized after use. Playgrounds and large gatherings will be temporarily closed. All activities will be done with safety in mind and strict room maximums will be followed.

- **How do we Check-In for Preschool Worship Care?**

- All self-check in stations will be closed. We will welcome you at the main desk in the Preschool Lobby to receive your tag and further instructions. A leader will be checking the temperature and performing a visual symptom check of the parent/guardian dropping off and the child(ren) being admitted for preschool care.

- **Why is only one parent/guardian allowed in the Preschool Suite?**

- In order to reduce foot traffic and maintain safe physical distancing we are requesting one parent/guardian and no siblings in the Preschool Suite. Please follow the one way directional signs and wait at your assigned classroom. If there is another parent/guardian dropping off, please maintain proper physical distancing. Please exit following the posted signs.

- **What about diaper bags?**

- In an effort to maintain cleanliness, we are limiting the number of outside items present in classrooms. This allows us to ensure the cleanliness of all classroom items for volunteer and child safety. You may keep all bags and items with you or leave them in the car. Any essentials for care may be labeled and placed in a gallon Ziploc baggie or sterilized container for contact free drop off. There will be an essentials station in the Preschool Lobby where you can label and remove all essential items that your child will need during the hour service. Please make sure everything is labeled with first and last names to prevent mix-ups.

- **How do we Pick-Up children?**

- Please send the same designated drop off/pick up person to pick up. They will present their tag visually to match security numbers. Parents will remove the tags from their children. Similar to Check-In, please follow the one way directional signs and wait at your assigned classroom. Please always maintain proper physical distancing and exit following the posted signs.

- **What changes in the classroom learning time will occur?**
  - At this time, we will be doing worship and story time in individual classrooms instead of gathering together as a large group. The playground will be closed until further notice. Your child will experience worship, a bible story, memory verse practice, application activities and games in a physically distant way. Chairs are spread out at tables and each child will have individual supplies to use. Also, we will not be serving snacks at this time.
- **What about older preschoolers and elementary children?**
  - Our church is following a phased reentry of ministries to our church campus. The return of ministries for older preschoolers and elementary age children occurs in a later phase. At this time, older preschoolers and elementary age children can participate in worship with their families as well as engage in activities virtually through our Mayfield Road Kids Facebook page ([www.facebook.com/mayfieldroadkids](http://www.facebook.com/mayfieldroadkids)).
