# Best Practices for Wellness & Security

## Wellness

At Mayfield Road, we want to spread the Gospel, not germs! Before each session, our team cleans all classroom surfaces, equipment, furniture and toys using a multi-step disinfectant process approved by the CDC and EPA.

We ask parents and guardians to commit to helping us by following these guidelines: Please do not bring your child if he/she has the following symptoms within the past 24 hours or has been treated for these symptoms within the past 24 hours:

- Cough
- Diarrhea
- Eye irritation
- Fever
- Lice
- Rash
- Runny nose
- Sore throat
- Vomiting

If your child develops any of these symptoms while in our care, you will be notified immediately and asked to keep your child with you for the remainder of the activity time.

## Security

We're passionate about reaching, building, and empowering the next generation and we take this responsibility seriously. Our policies and procedures make Mayfield Road a safe and secure place for kids to learn and grow. Upon arrival, our leaders will help you check-in your child using our check-in system. You will receive a security tag that must be used when you return to pick up your child. This ensures that only you and other people you have authorized have permission to take your child from our care. We encourage guests with preschool and elementary-age children to check-in at the desk located in the Preschool Suite.

All leaders serving with Mayfield Road Kids complete a thorough background check and screening as well as receive ongoing training to ensure your child has the best experience while engaged in our ministry environments.
