Rhea has an MA in Conflict Resolution from Portland State University. In her current role as Restorative Justice Specialist Senior for Multnomah County Juvenile Services Division Rhea is responsible for providing restorative justice based training and consultation, offering policy recommendations rooted in restorative justice, and overseeing restorative justice based programming (i.e. Victim Offender Dialogue). Rhea spent several years working with Insight Development Group, where she facilitated restorative justice dialogue groups at both adult and juvenile correctional facilities. She served on the board the Oregon Peace Institute for several years and recently published a peer reviewed volume with McFarland— "Conflict Transformation: Essays on Methods of Nonviolence" that focuses on under-represented and marginalized voices within the field of Conflict Resolution. Rhea is currently working on an anthology project that brings the voices of the incarcerated population into the forefront of discourse on restorative justice.
