Equip Pathway

Purpose

The Equip Pathway aims to provide believers with a solid foundation in Christ, enabling them to fulfill the unique purpose God has created them for.

Description

The Equip Pathway consists of 4 6-week courses that will deepen believers' knowledge of Christian discipleship, the biblical narrative, and Christian theology. Participants will learn alongside others in an interactive classroom. Each course will challenge believers with required readings, group discussions, and light homework assignments.

Each course is offered in both the fall and spring. After completing all 4 courses, participants will have a commission celebration.

The courses:

- 1. EP 101 Christian Formation:
 - a. A 6-week course that teaches participants how to live gospel-transformed lives as disciples and apprentices of Jesus.
- 2. EP 102-A Old Testament Narrative:
 - a. A 6-week course that teaches participants the overarching story of the Old Testament. This is part of a two-part class where participants will learn the grand story told throughout the entire Bible.
- 3. EP 102-B New Testament Narrative:
 - a. A 6-week course that teaches participants the overarching story of the New Testament. This is part of a two-part class where participants will learn the grand story told throughout the entire Bible.
- 4. EP 103 Christian Theology:
 - a. A 6-week course that teaches students the core beliefs of the Christian faith and helps students understand the biblical evidence for their beliefs. The course includes lessons on the Trinity, the person and work of Christ, the atonement, the Holy Spirit, and more.

Commitment

The Equip Pathway requires a commitment from each participant. Each course is 6-weeks long, so participants should be committed to attending each session to the best of their ability. Likewise, a financial commitment of \$20 is required for each course (for course materials). The course will require 1-3 hours per week of reading or homework outside of class.

When

Classes meet on Wednesdays. Childcare is provided. The courses are offered every Spring and Fall.
