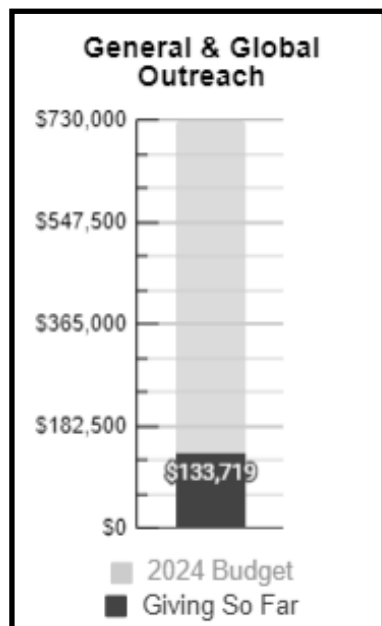

Set up an Elexio account for access to RLHC's online directory

- Download the Elexio Community app on your smart device or, if using a computer, go to richfieldlife.elexiochms.com/user/login
- To create your account, sign in on the login page by doing the following:
 - for domain, type richfieldlife
 - for username, type your first and last name separated by a period (firstname.lastname)
 - click on forgot password and then give your email address
- Check email to retrieve temporary password and login with username and temporary password
- To reset password, go to home page, and then:
 - with iphone, click on your name near the bottom
 - with android, click on my profile near the bottom and then the circle with three dots
 - with computer, go to your profile and select the account tab at the top
- Your account should be ready to use, and you should have access to the church directory information on your smart device or computer. If you have questions, please contact the church office.
