January minutes of the Council of Elders and Administration Team meetings and financial information are available at the Welcome Centers.

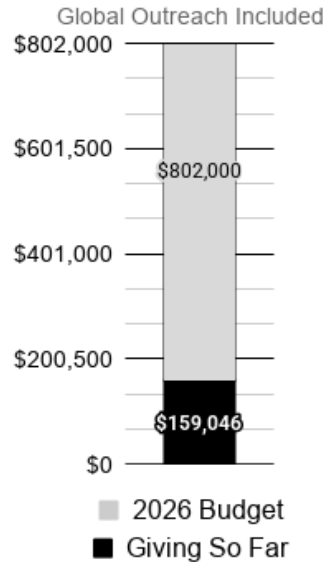
