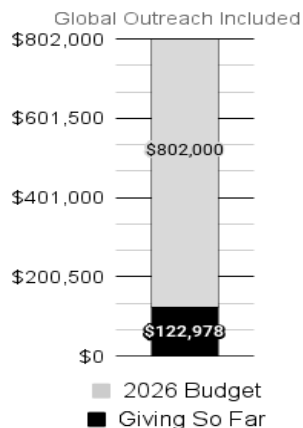
Child Dedication is scheduled for Sunday, April 12 and every second Sunday of each month. If you are interested in having your child dedicated, contact the church office.
