Child Dedication is scheduled for Sunday, September 13 and the second Sunday of each month. If you are interested in having your child dedicated, contact the church office.

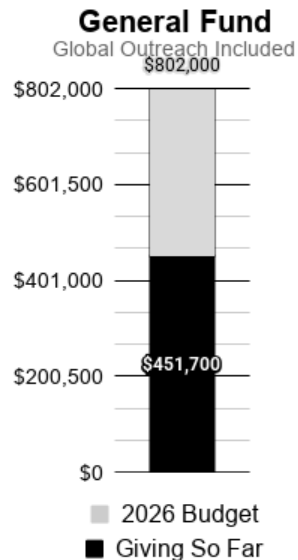
