## STORY FROM JEFF & KATIE LOGUE

After much prayer and grappling with God, we decided to take a huge leap of faith when filling out our Commitment Card. We'd been giving faithfully for years, but in this season something inside us shifted. It became crystal clear that the idol of money had set up a throne within our hearts, and that our regular giving had become almost a second nature response instead of an ongoing attitude of surrender.

So we wrote down our number and plunged into deeper waters. Looking back, even in that moment, we were still relying on our own plans coming together in our own power. And ironically just a week later I (Jeff) made a joint decision to close down my business of 4.5 years, vanishing our primary source of income.

This wasn't how it was supposed to go, right? Shouldn't blessing accompany obedience? We've learned that blessing doesn't always come immediately or even in the way we expect it, and that while we may we think we know what we need, that God alone knows what's actually best for us. He will provide everything we truly need, and our role is to simply trust in His plans and not our own. It's in this awkward and often uncomfortable valley of surrender where we experience an unshakable peace and freedom that nothing in this world could ever offer. We look forward with greater expectation and a renewed sense of hope in the One who owns it all and promises never to forsake us.
